SUMMARY:

The Club Physical Therapist will be primarily responsible for the rehabilitation of the Player. The Physical Therapist will report directly to the Chief Medical Officer and Head Athletic Trainer/Head of Medical. Under that supervision, the Physical Therapist will coordinate rehabilitation, evaluations, plan of care, progress notes, and discharge notes on all Players. These notes need to be kept on file in the MLS electronic medical record (EMR).

Key Responsibilities:

- Develop and implement individualized physical therapy treatment plans for San Diego FC athletes.
- Conduct thorough assessments of athletes' physical conditions to diagnose issues and plan interventions.
- Provide hands-on therapy, including manual therapy techniques, to alleviate pain and restore function.
- Oversee rehabilitation programs to ensure athletes' safe and effective return to play.
- Collaborate with team physicians and other healthcare professionals to coordinate comprehensive care.
- Educate athletes on injury prevention techniques, proper body mechanics, and performance enhancement strategies.
- Maintain detailed records of athletes' treatment plans, progress notes, and outcomes.
- Ensure the physical therapy facilities and equipment are properly maintained and stocked.
- Stay current with advancements in physical therapy practices and incorporate evidence-based techniques.
- Participate in the planning and implementation of strength and conditioning programs to optimize athletic performance and prevent injuries.
