Cidade Universitária Armando Salles de Oliveira (CUASO)

Inaugurated in 1968, in the west zone of São Paulo (SP), Cidade Universitária Armando Salles de Oliveira houses the central administrative structure of USP, as well as several teaching units, the Residential Complex, the Sports Practice Center and the University Hospital within its more than eight million square meters. It also hosts several institutions, much of it with academic links with USP.

How to reach Cidade Universitária?

The place is easily accessible by public transport. Cidade Universitária is served within its campus by Butantã Station of Line 4 of the São Paulo Metro. On the Butantã Terminal, take a bus named “Circular I - Metrô Butantã / Cidade Universitária (8012)” or “Circular 2 - Metrô Butantã / Cidade Universitária (8022)”. 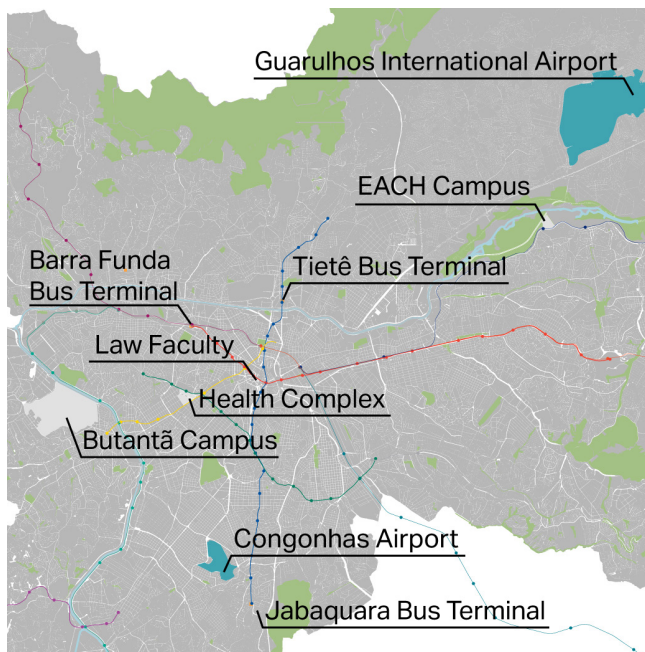
