

eBay International Shipping Setting and managing country exclusions

This step-by-step guide will show you a few ways to control where you sell your items by setting and managing country exclusions while staying enrolled in eBay International Shipping. Depending on what you sell, you might want to change the settings on a few listings that aren't eligible for export—you can do that using the bulk edit tool for several listings at once or edit them individually with the single listing tool.

If you use business policies to manage listings, you can update country exclusions there, too. And if you never want to ship any of your items to a certain region or country you can set that up with account-level exclusions.

We'll go through each of these options one by one. Use the table of contents on the following page to navigate to a specific approach.

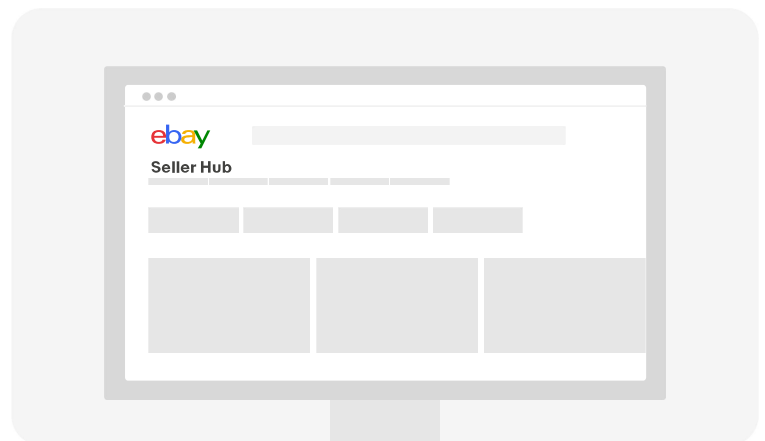
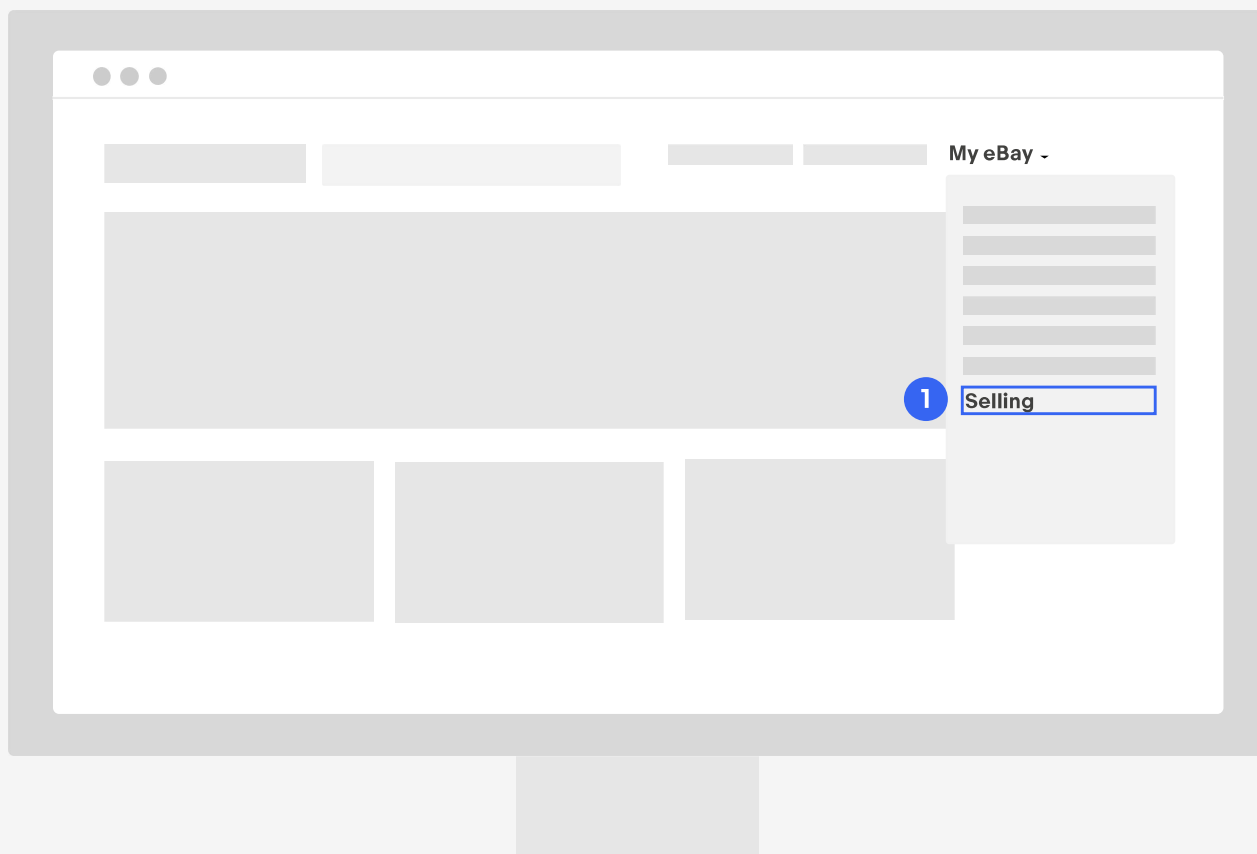

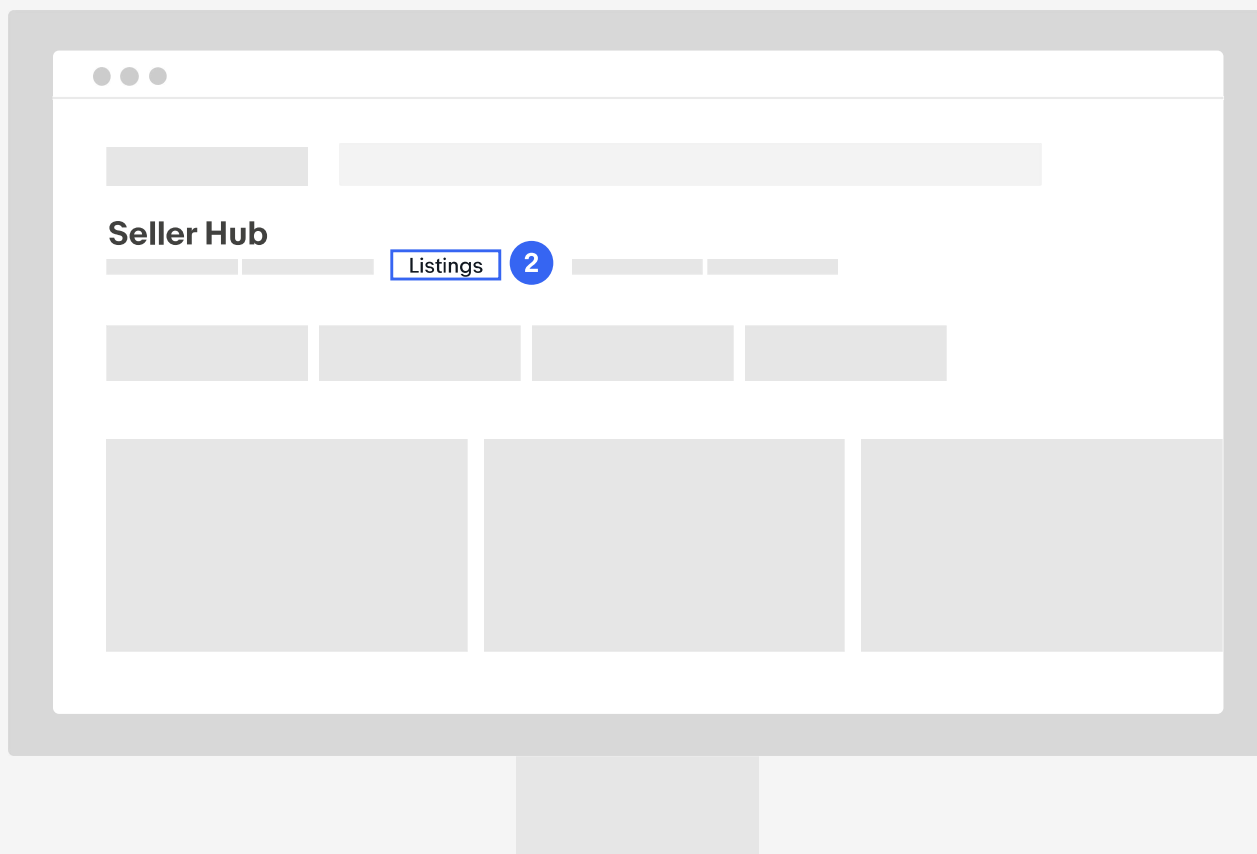

Step 1

In the upper right corner of your screen, hover over the My eBay dropdown menu and select “Selling.”

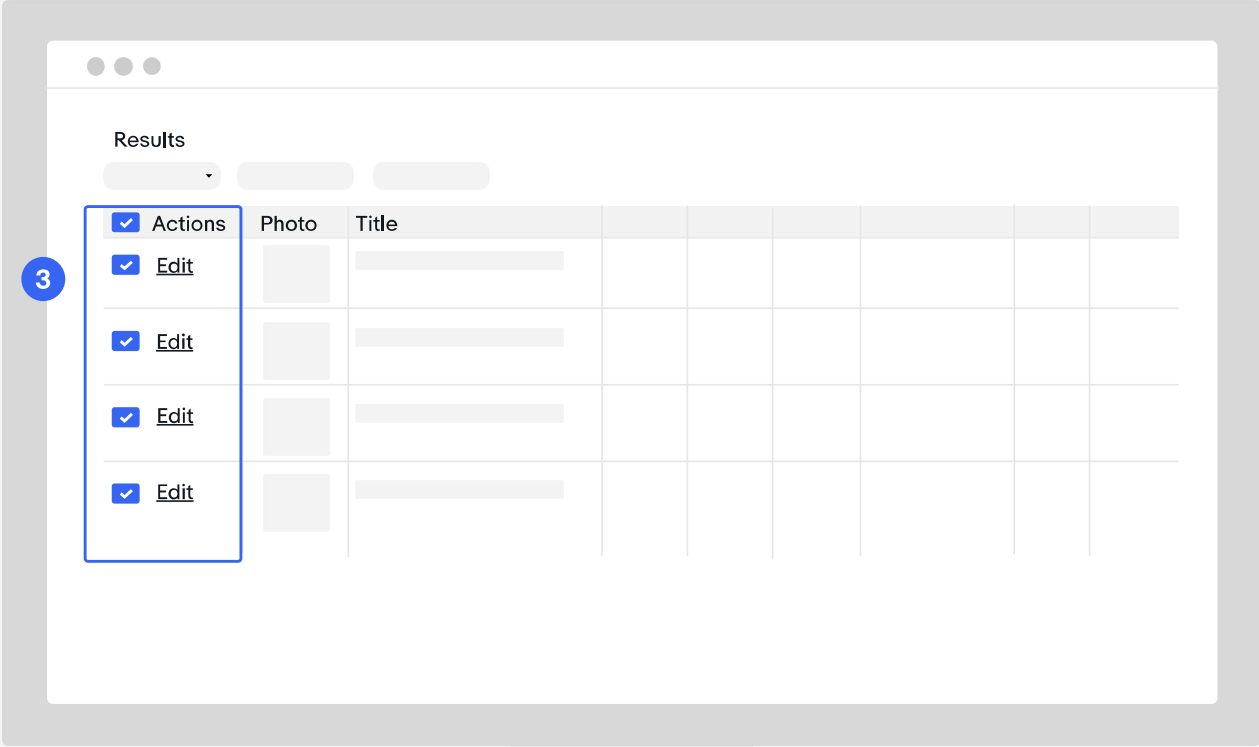

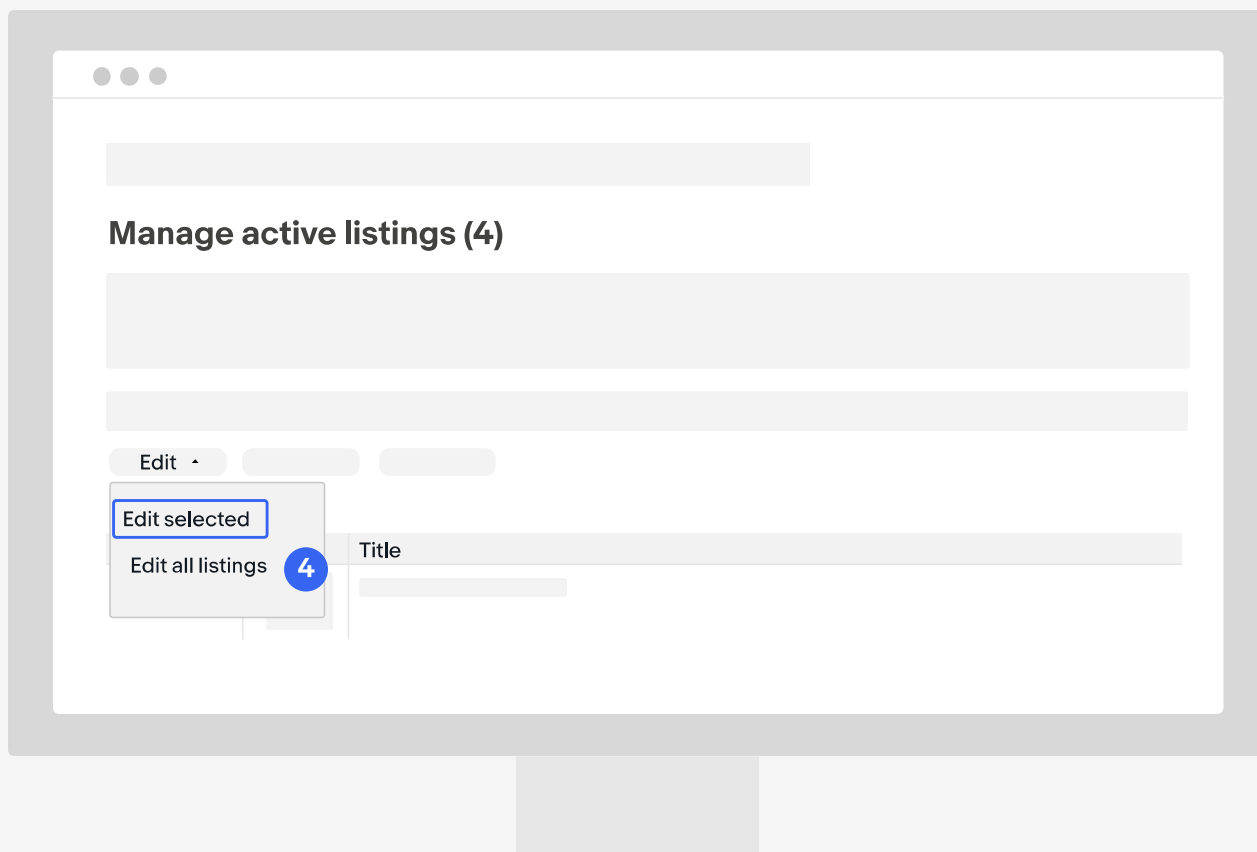
Select "Listings" from the top menu of your Seller Hub.

Select the listings you want to edit.

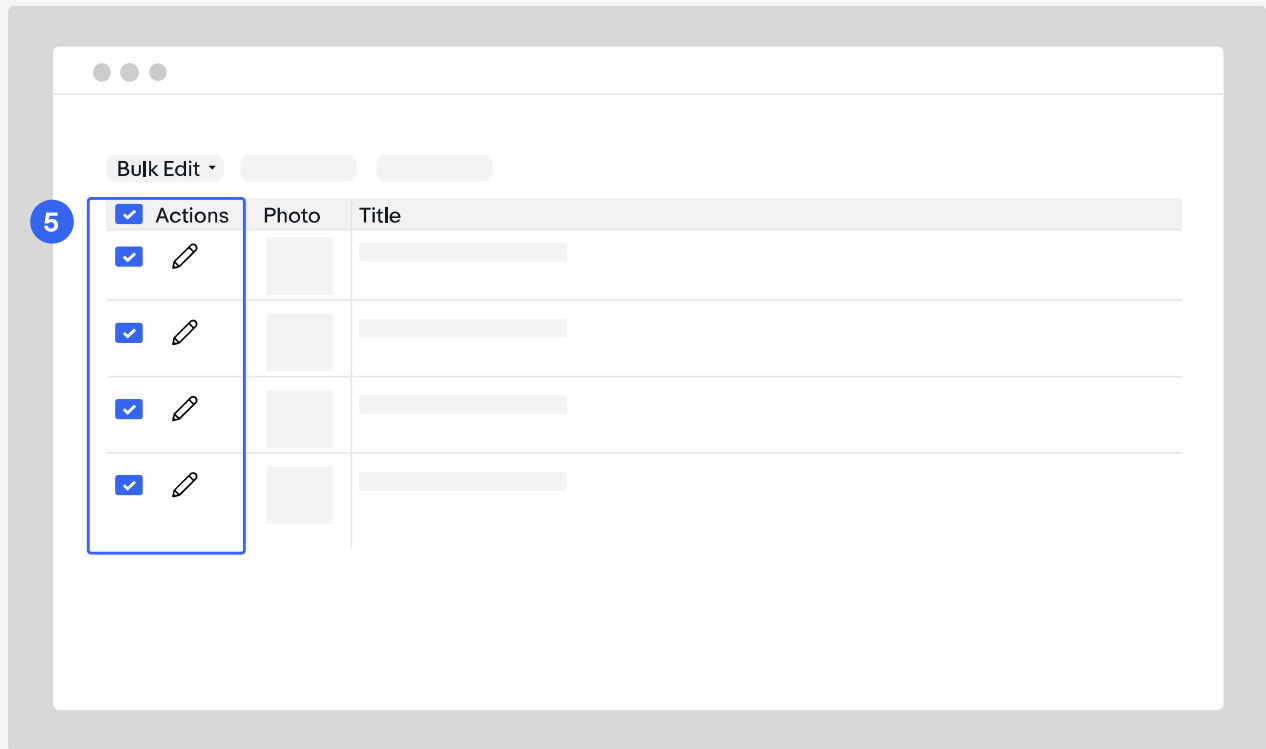

Scroll down to your active listings. Click on the edit dropdown and select "Edit selected."

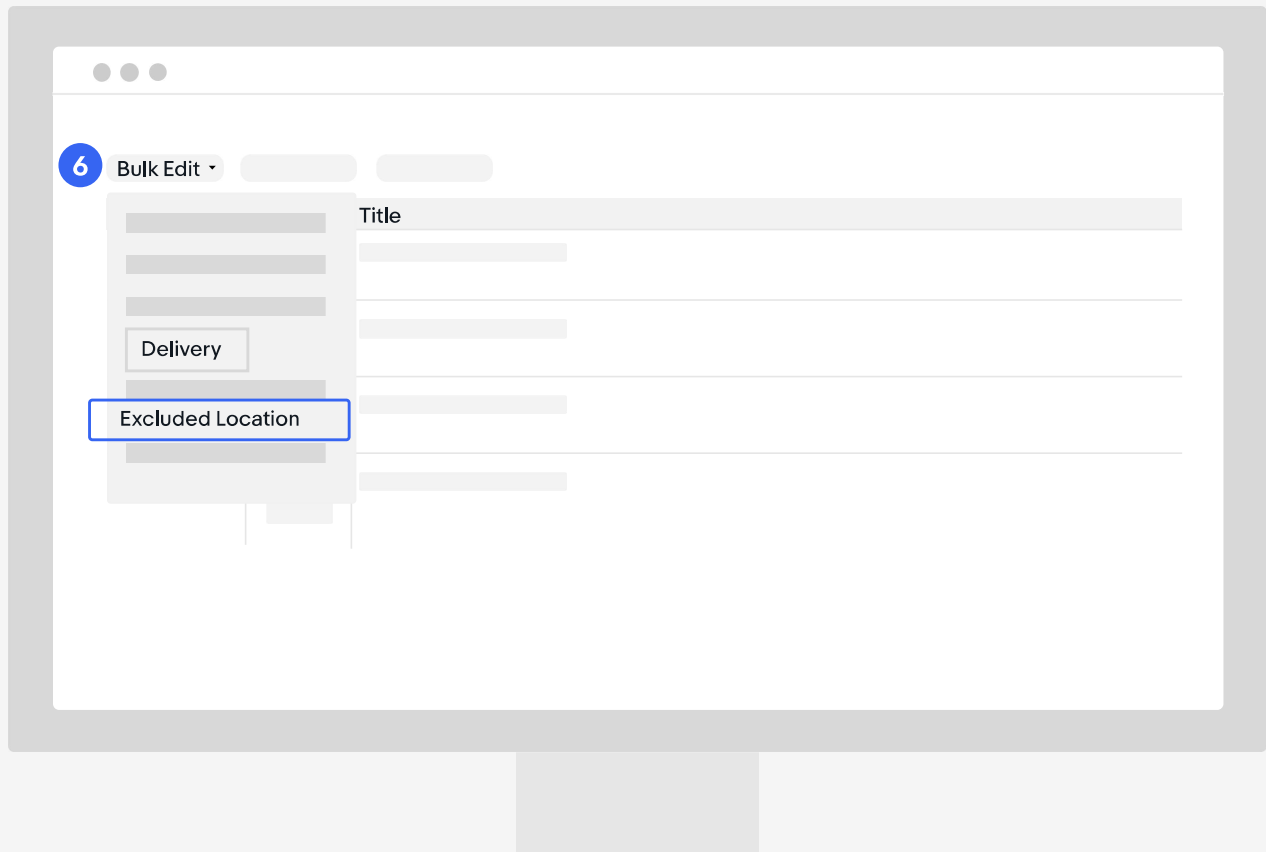

Select the cell above all listings.

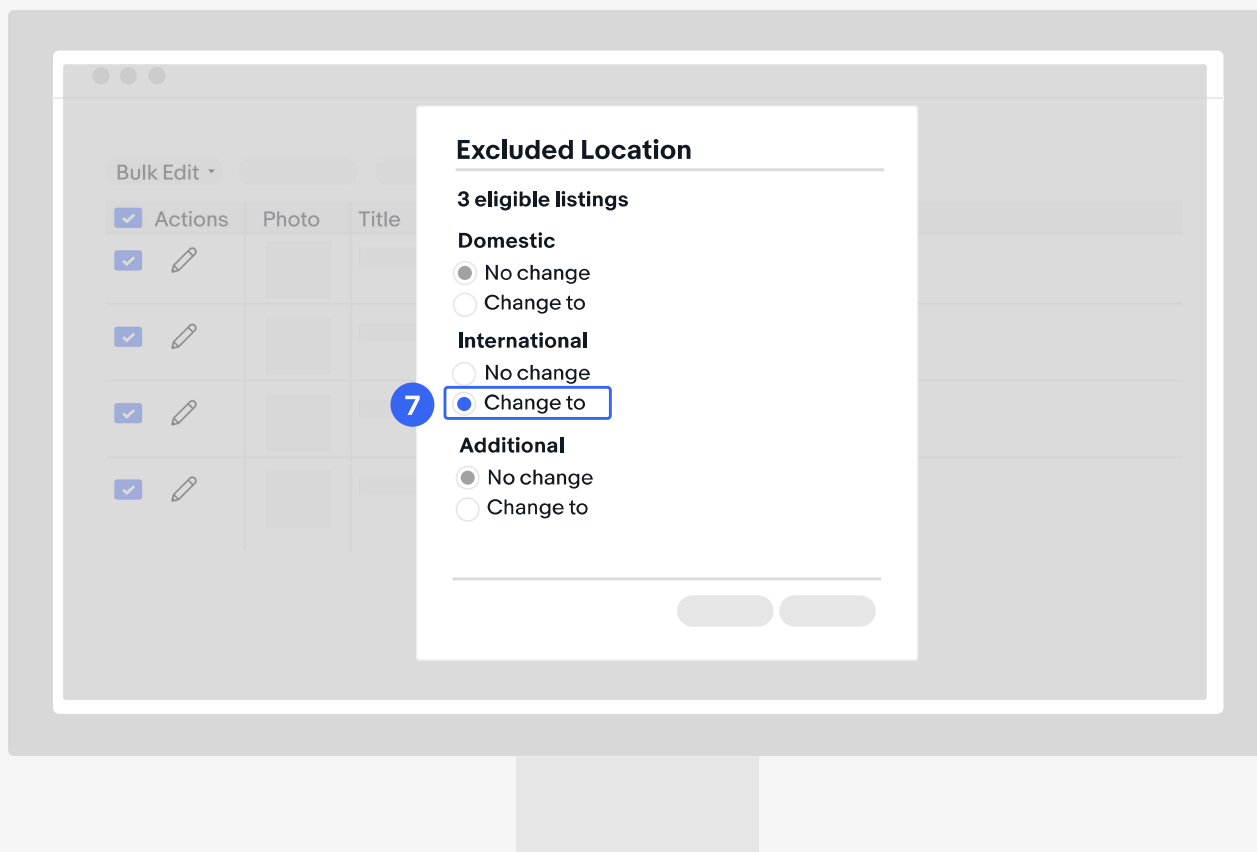

Click on the “Bulk Edit” button and select “Excluded Location” from the Delivery section.

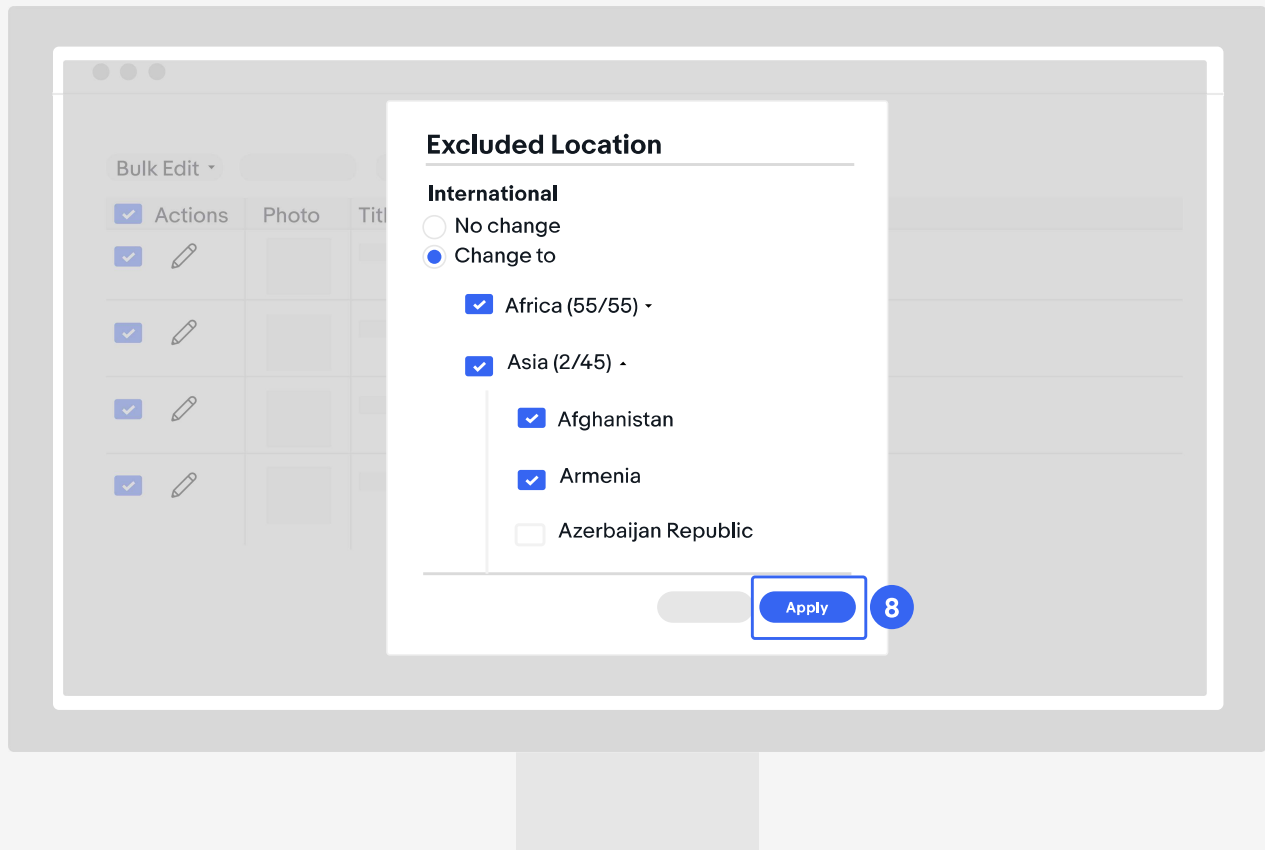

Click “Change to” under “International.”

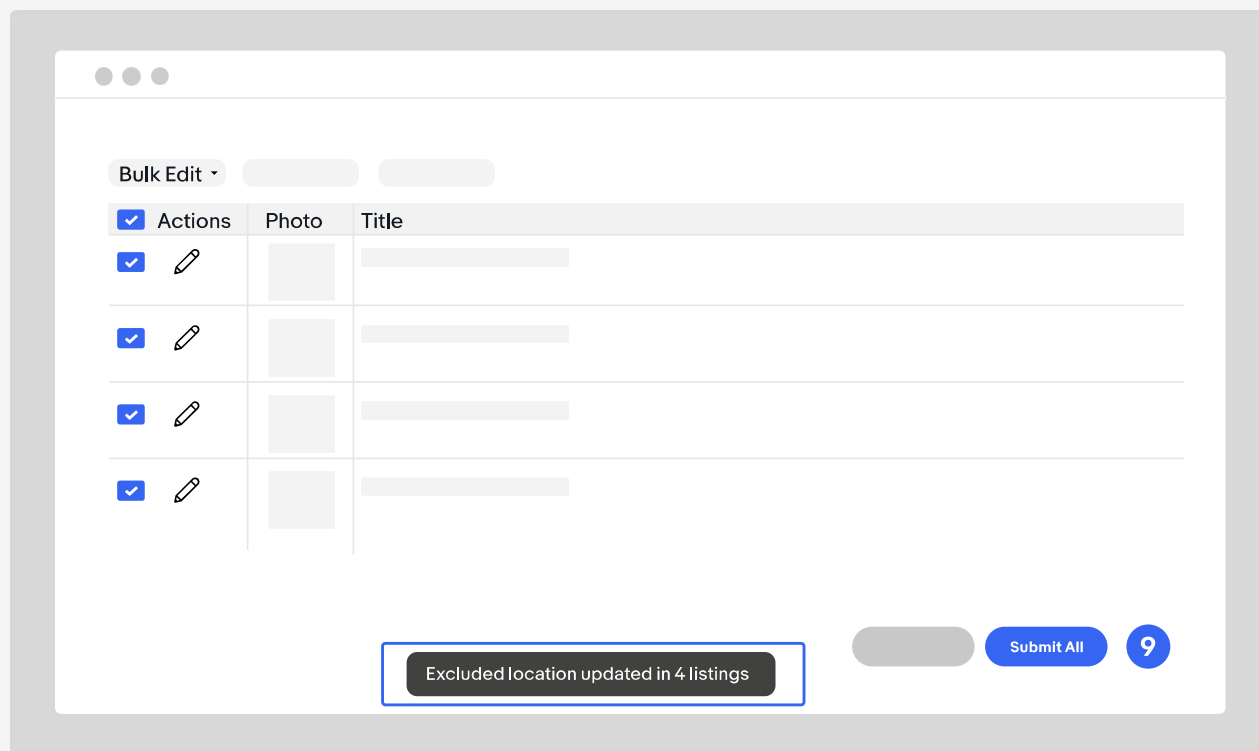

Click “Apply.”

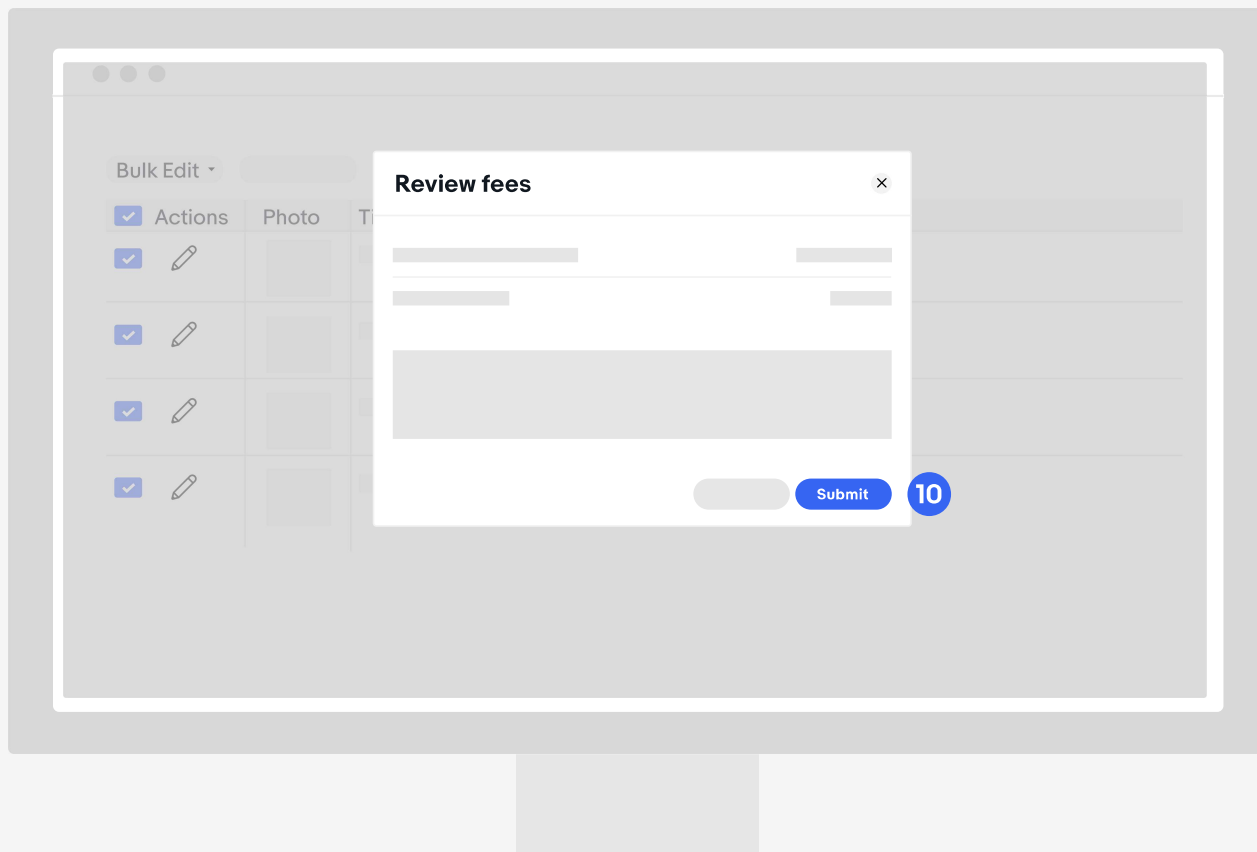

You will see a confirmation at the bottom. Click "Submit All."

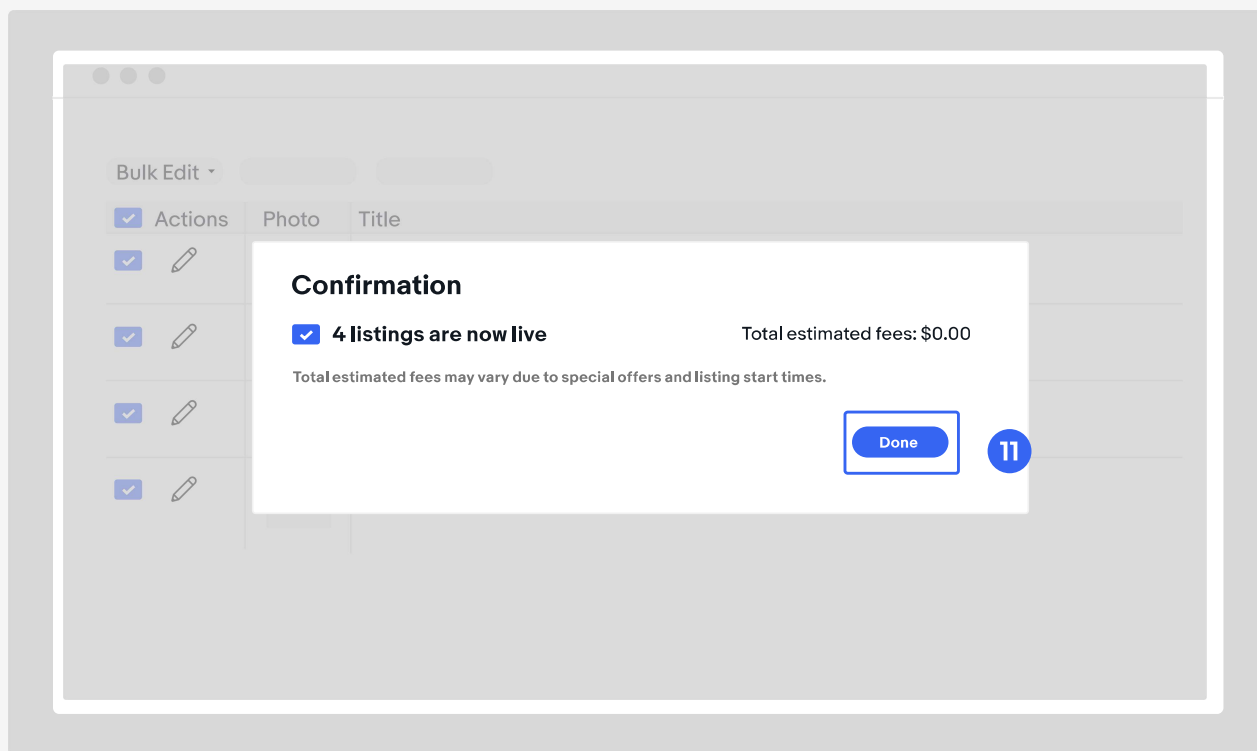

Then, click “Submit.”

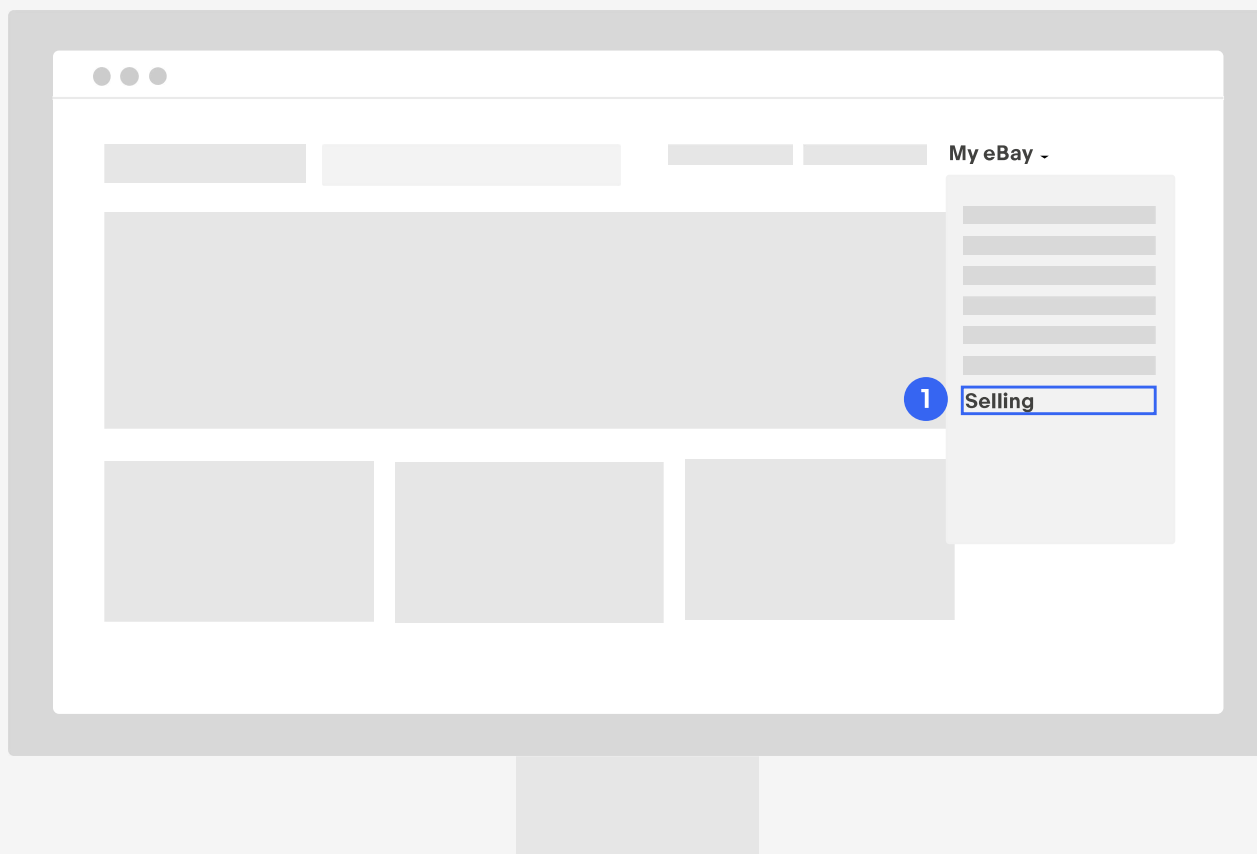

You will see a confirmation of your change. Click “Done.”

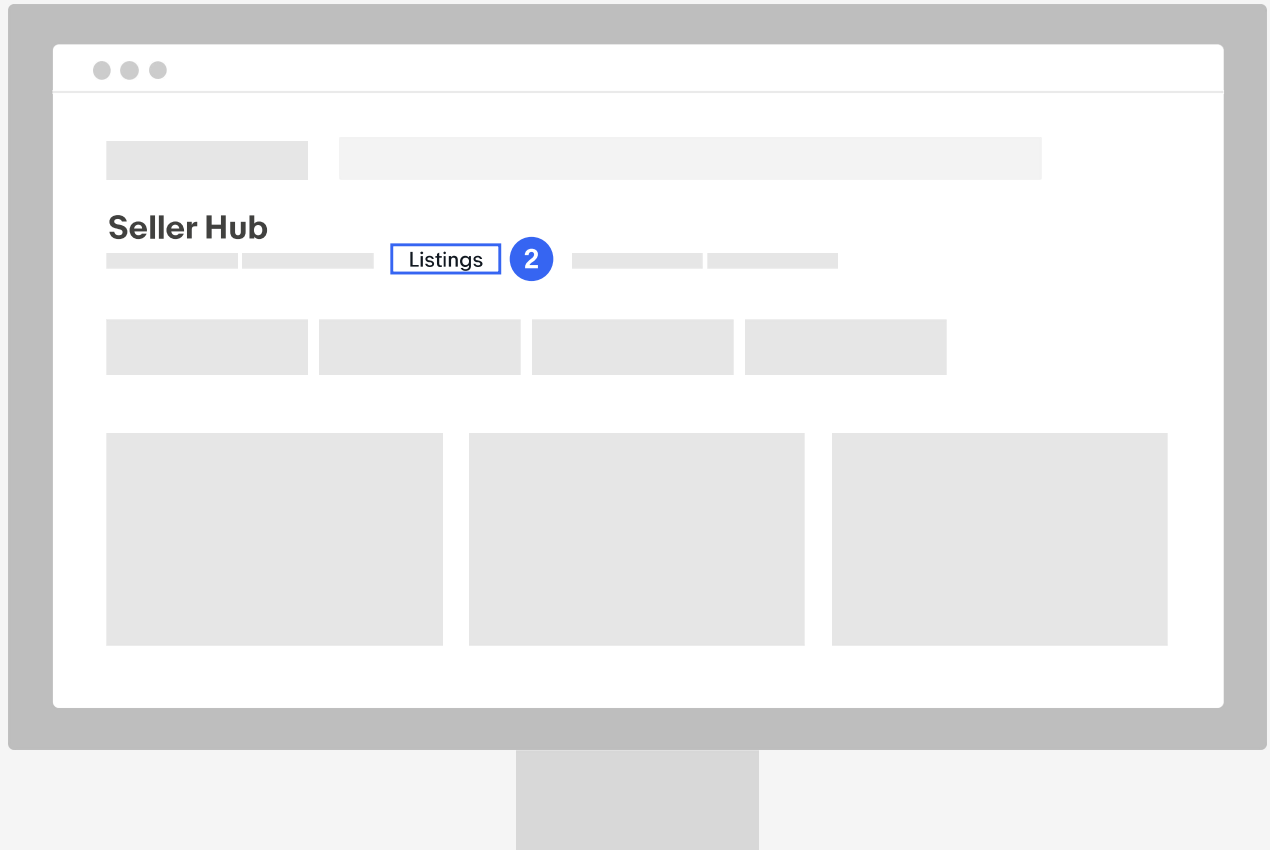

In the upper right corner of your screen, hover over the My eBay dropdown menu and select “Selling.”

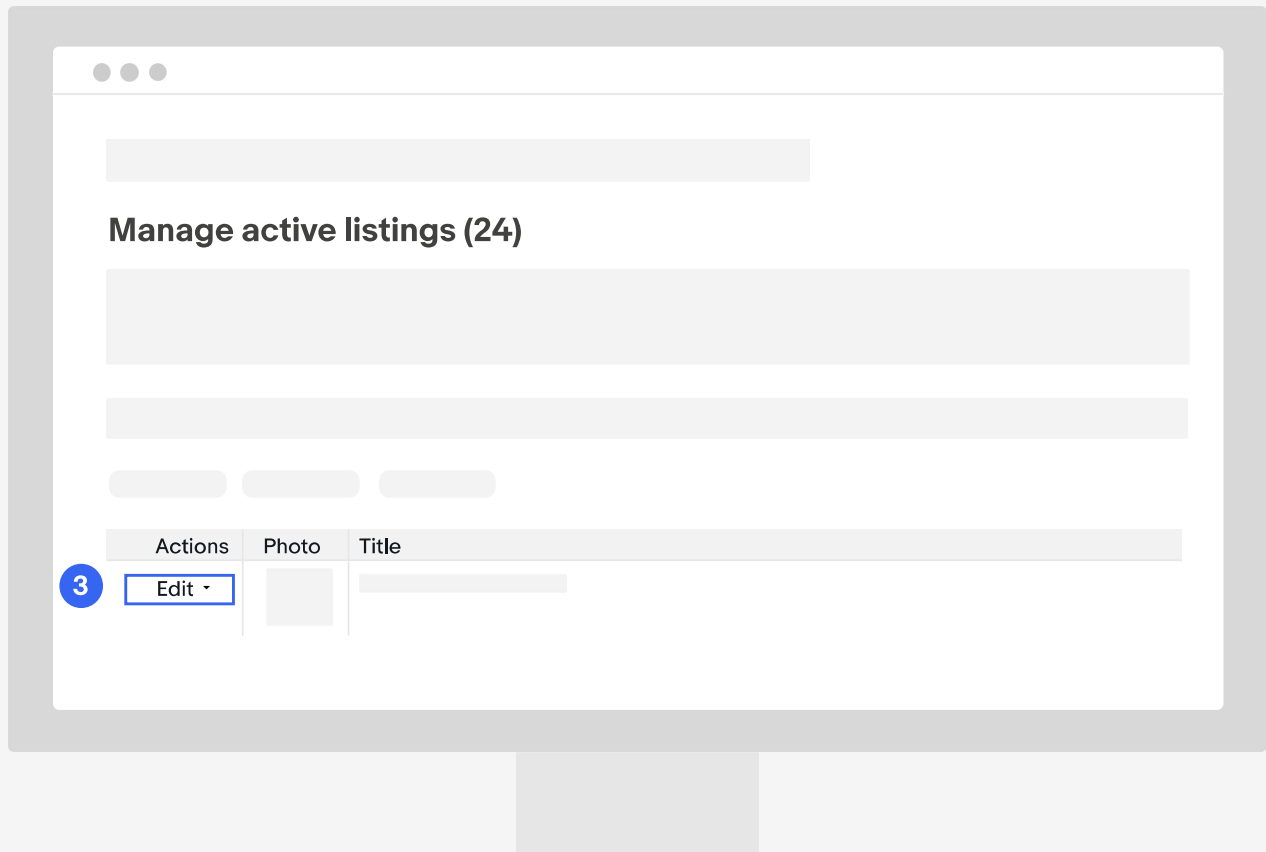

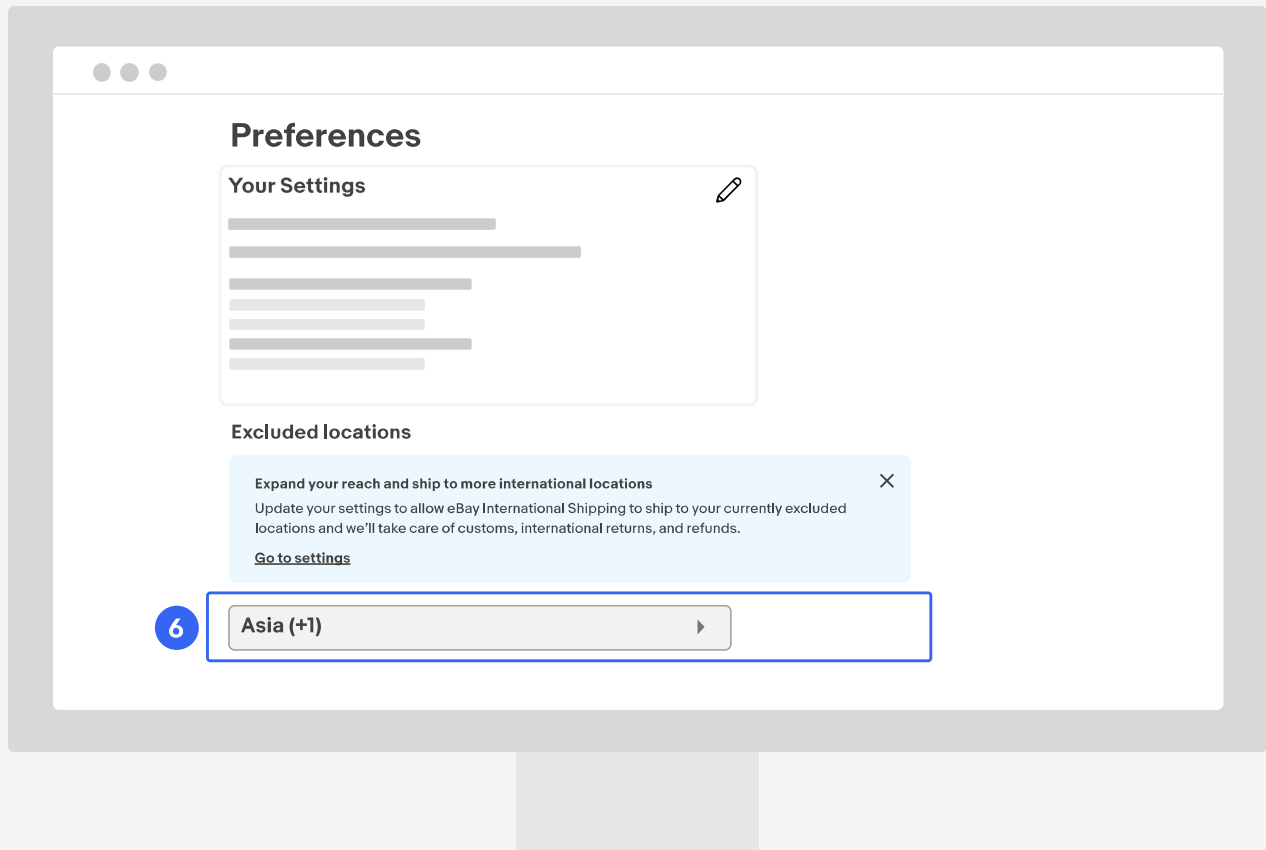

In the dropdown, scroll down and toggle “Excluded locations.”

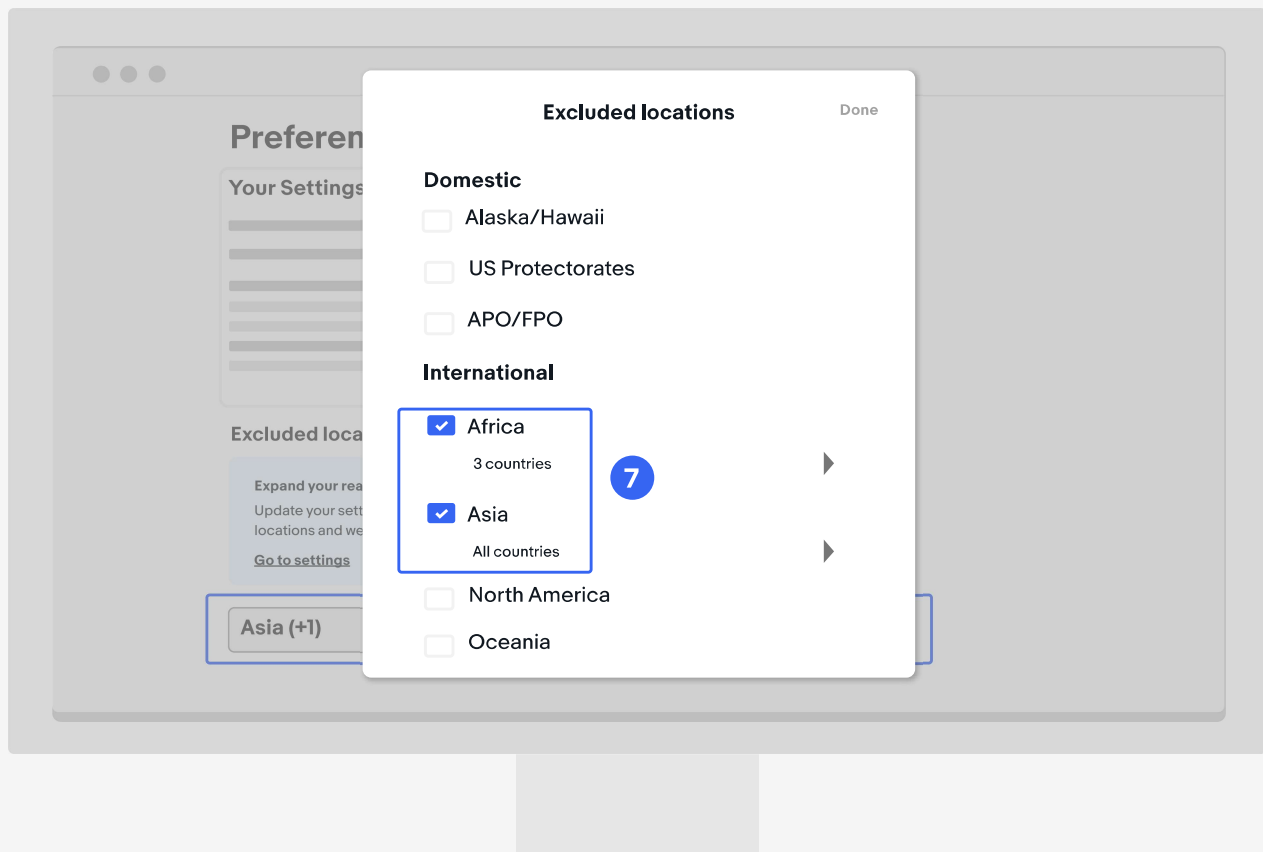

Navigate to your Preferences and “Excluded locations.”

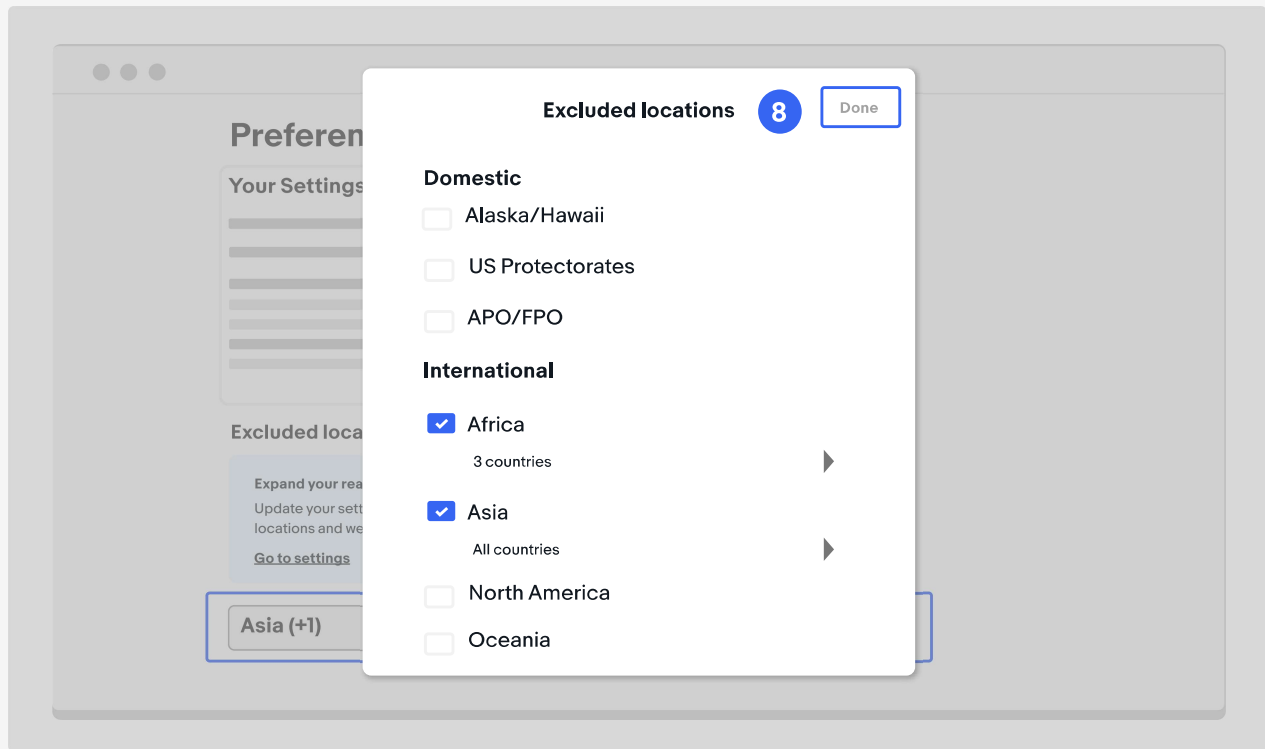

In the pop-up, select all the locations under the international section that you want to exclude. Or, to keep this listing in the U.S. only, select all the locations under the international section.

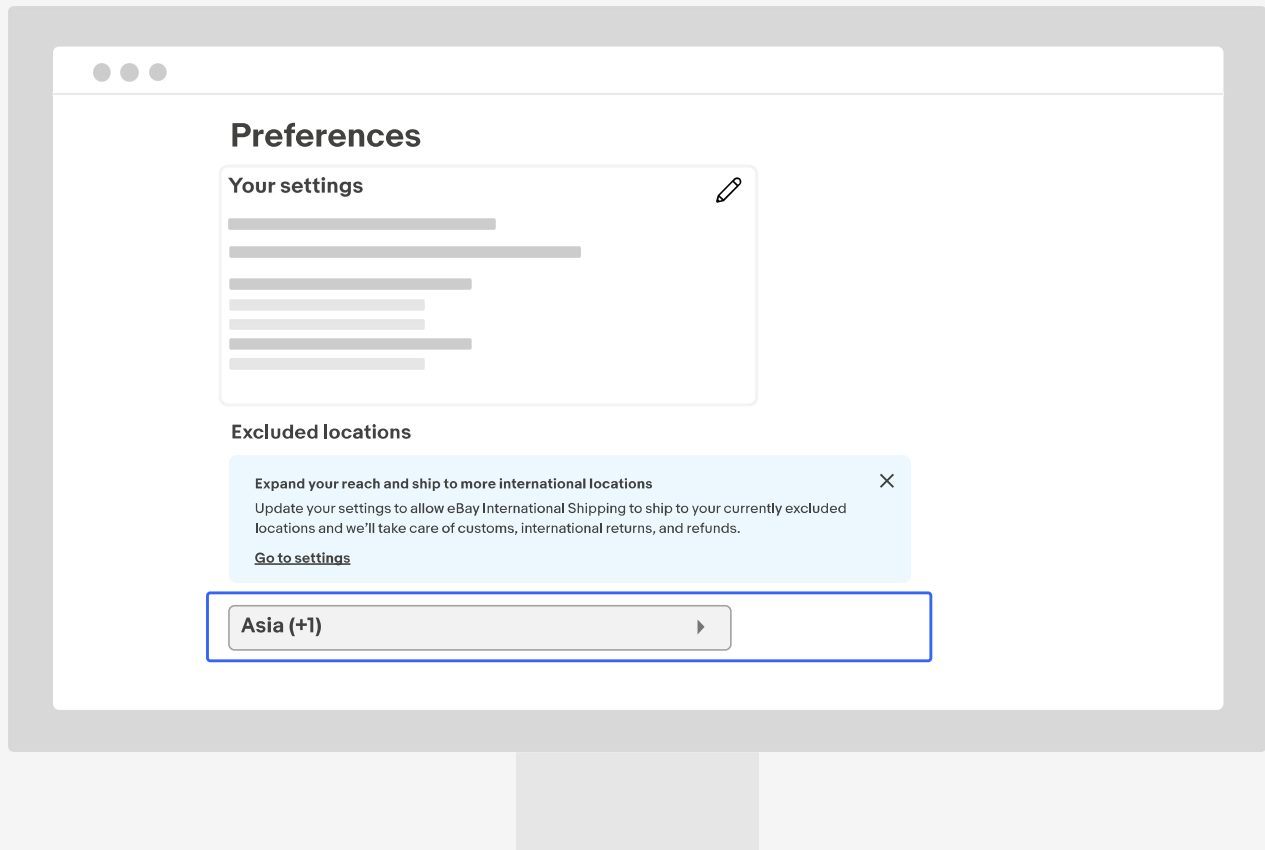

Step 8

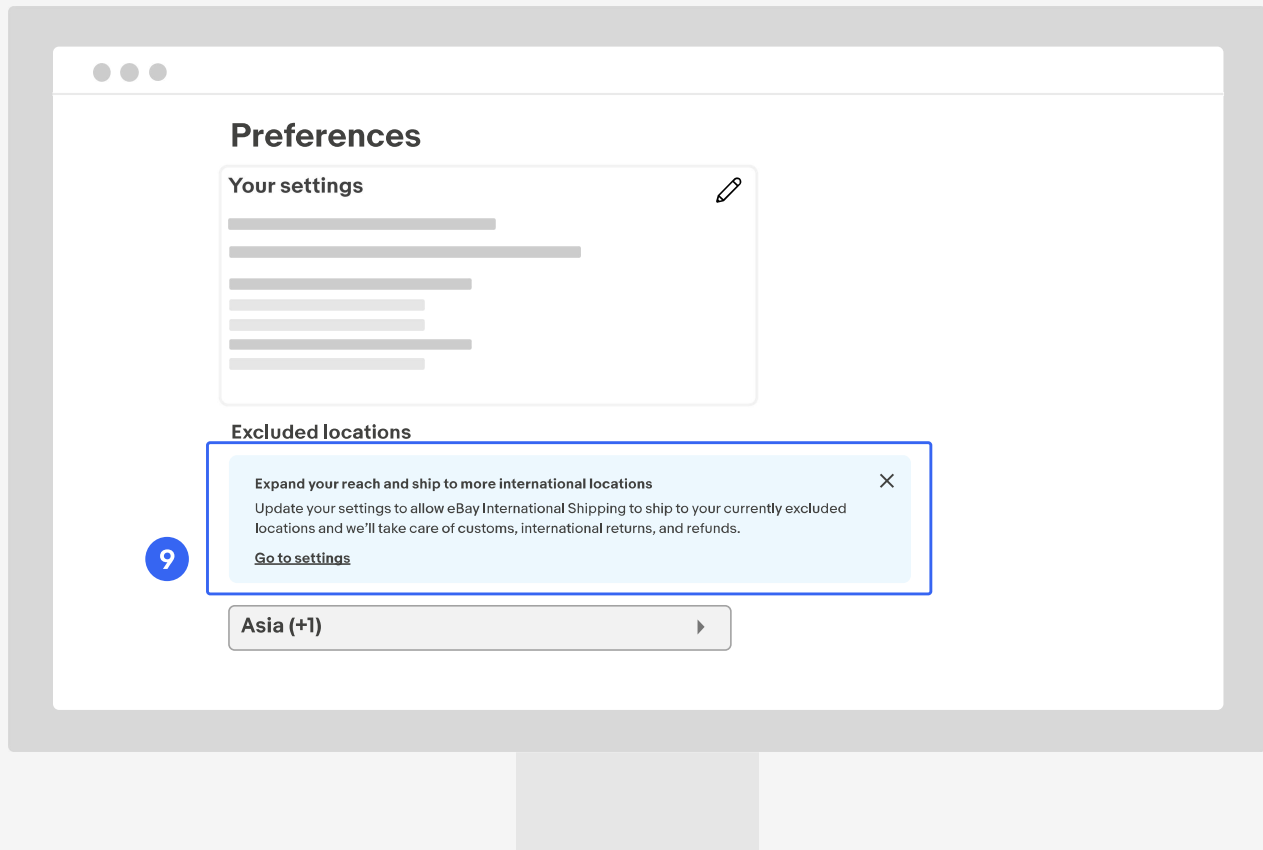
Select "Done" in the top-right corner of the "Excluded locations" window.

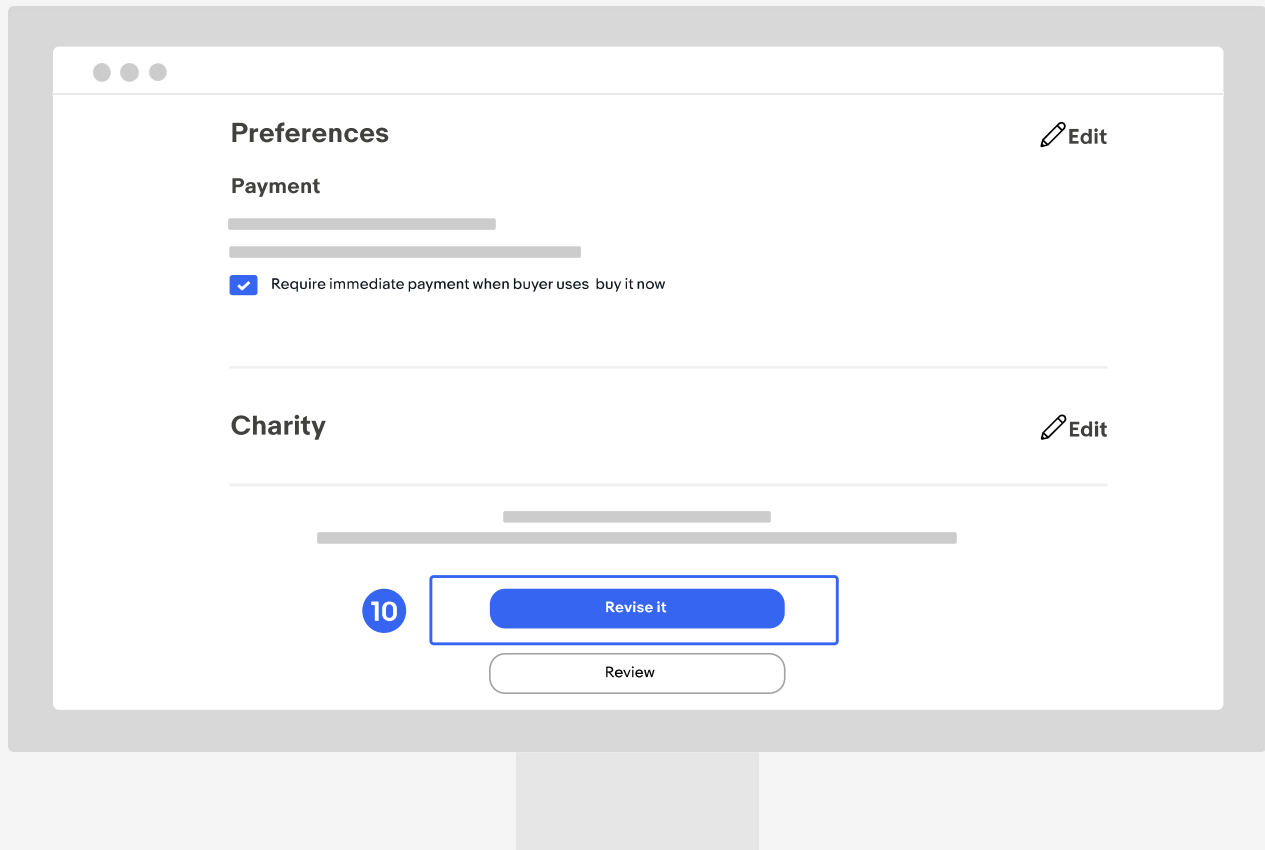


Step 9 (optional)

Consider allowing eBay to ship to your excluded locations through an eBay managed service, like eBay International Shipping.

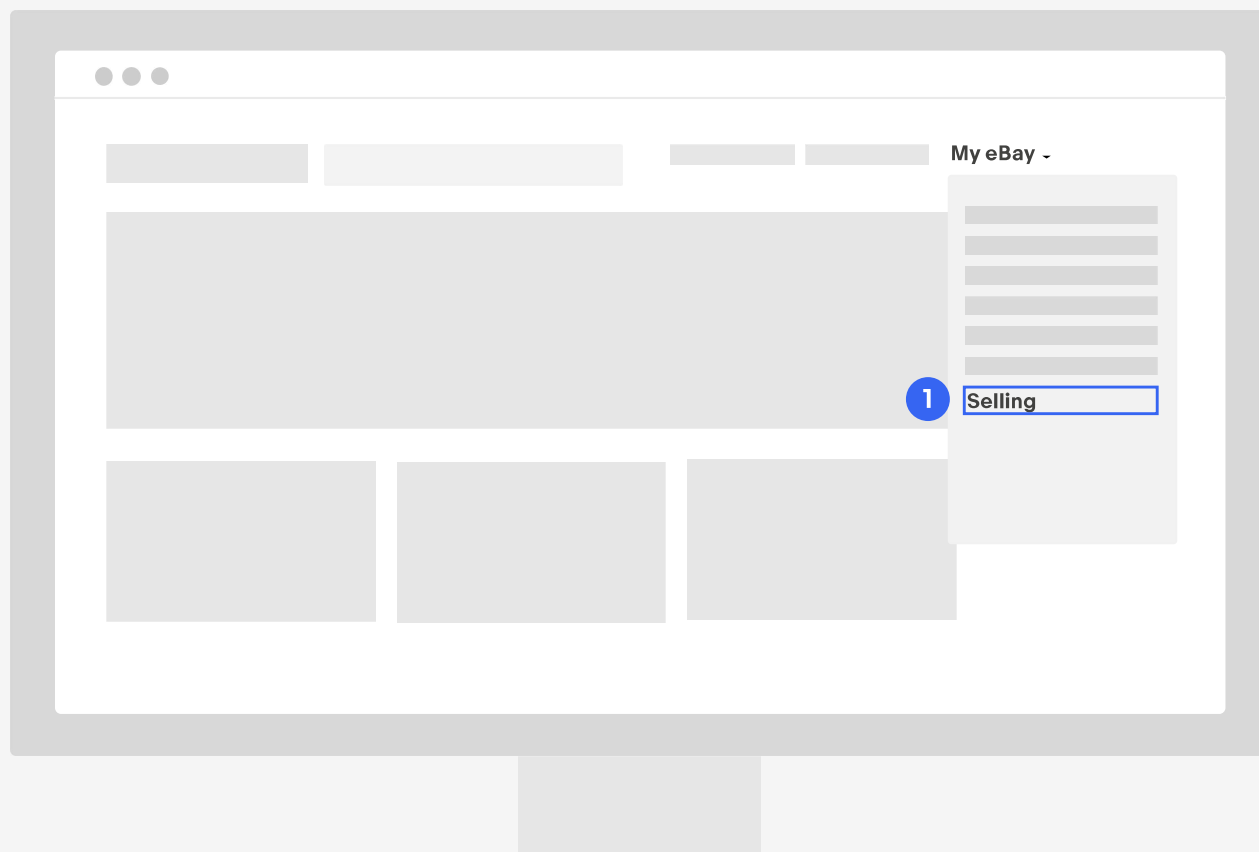

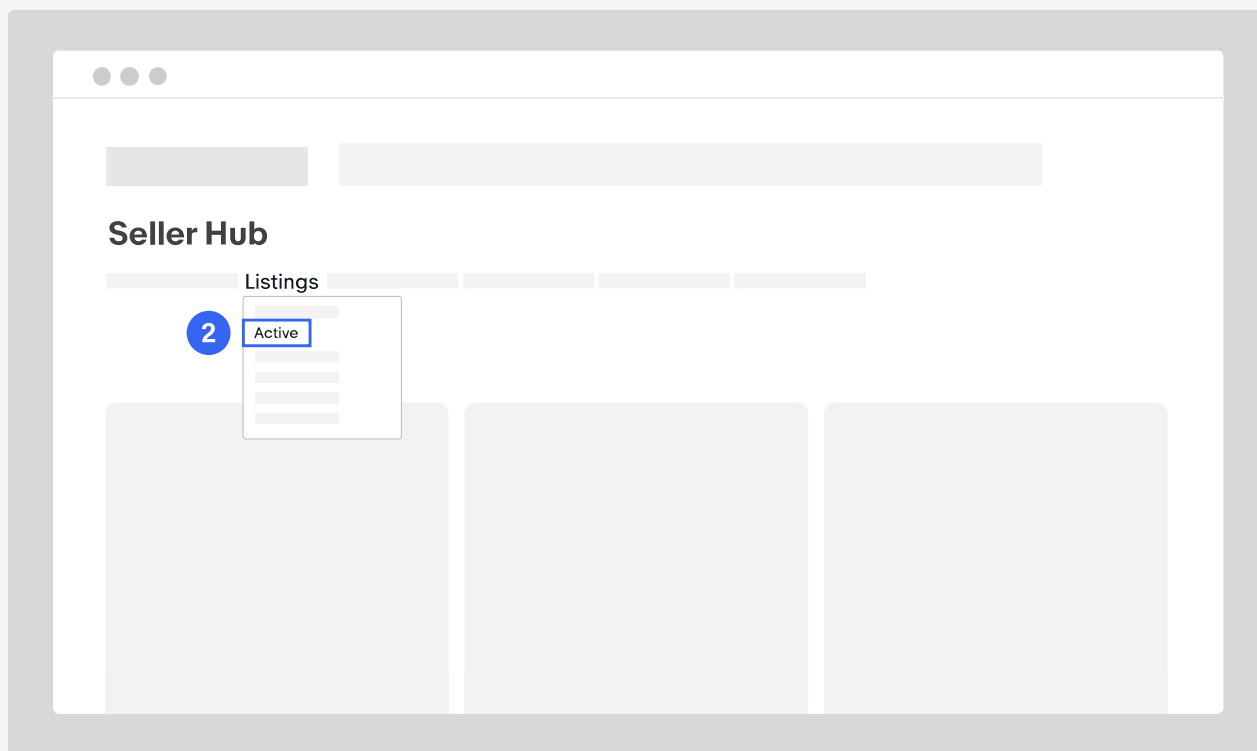
Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click "Revise it."

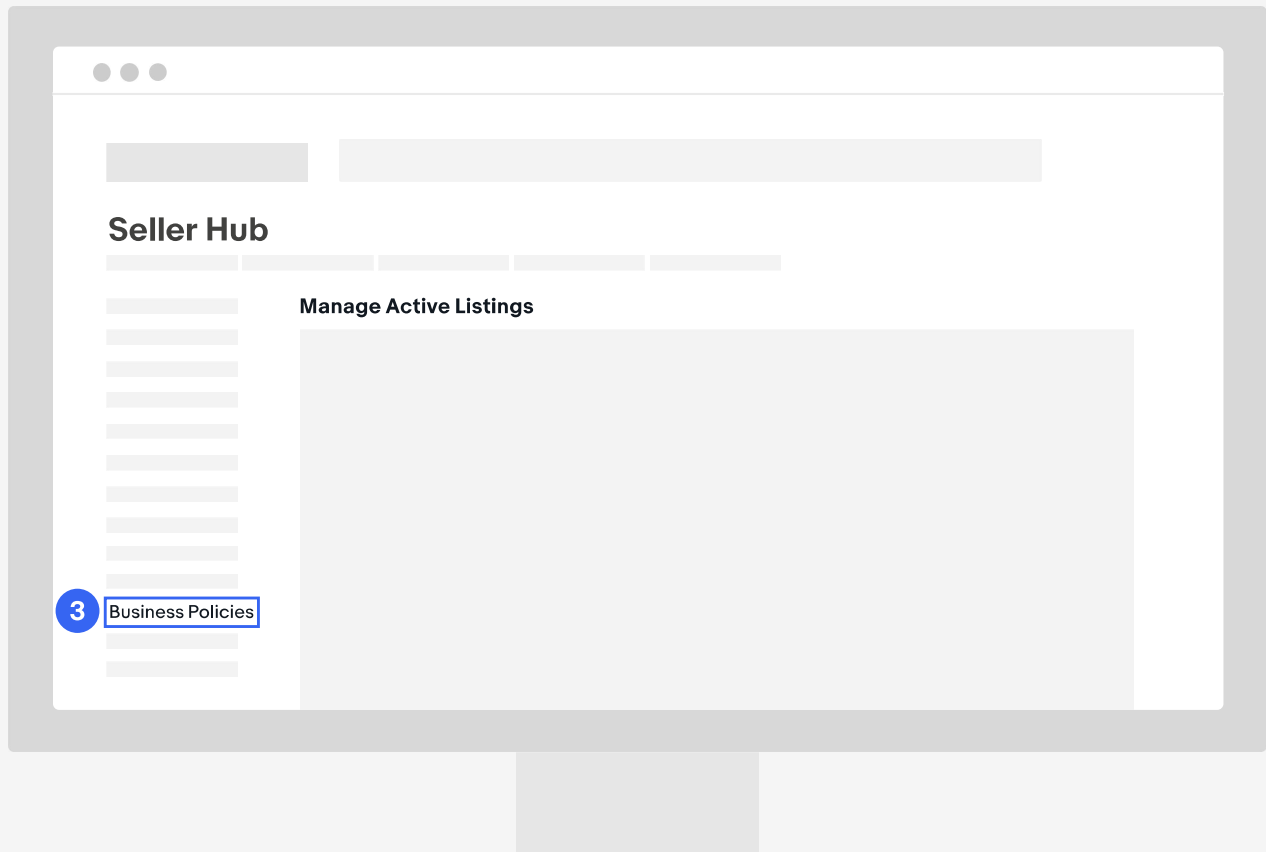

Hover over "Listings," then select "Active" from the dropdown.

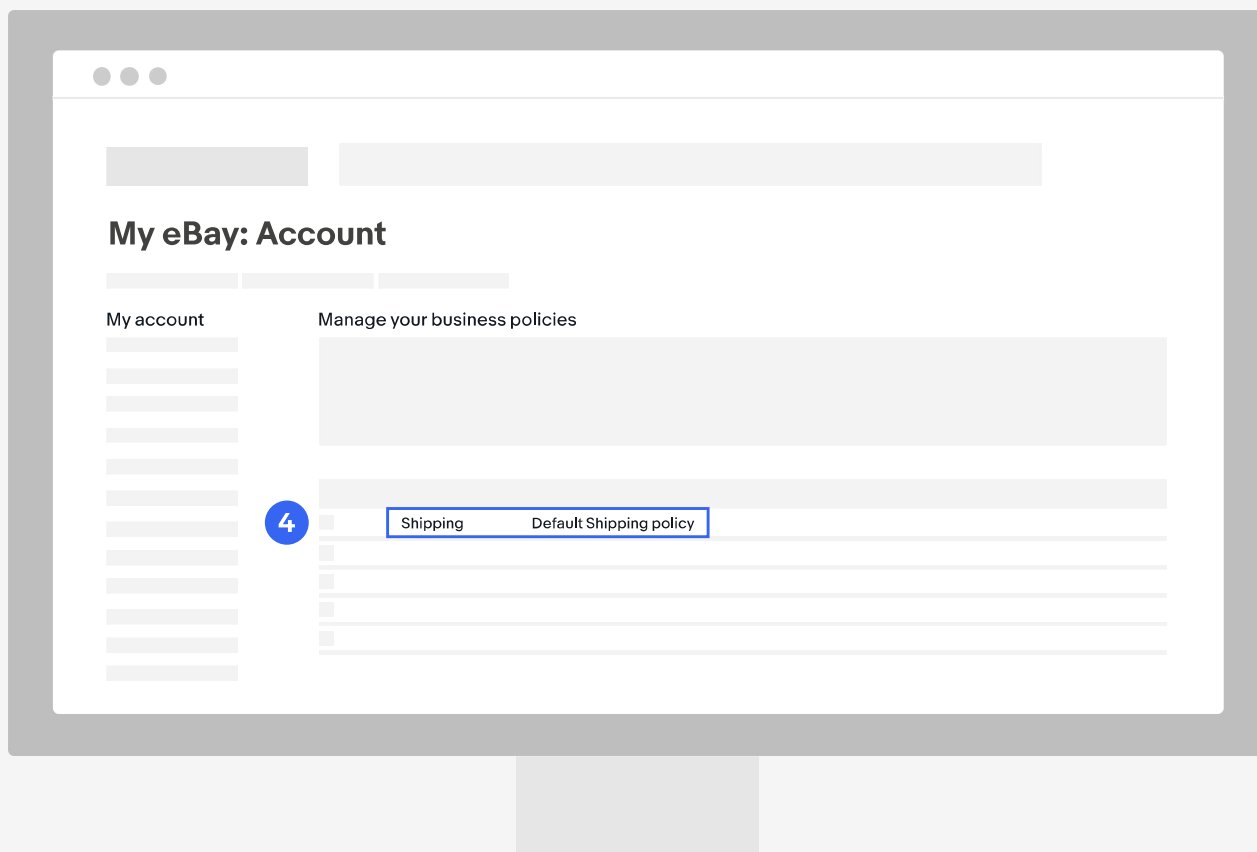

Select "Business Policies" on the lefthand side.

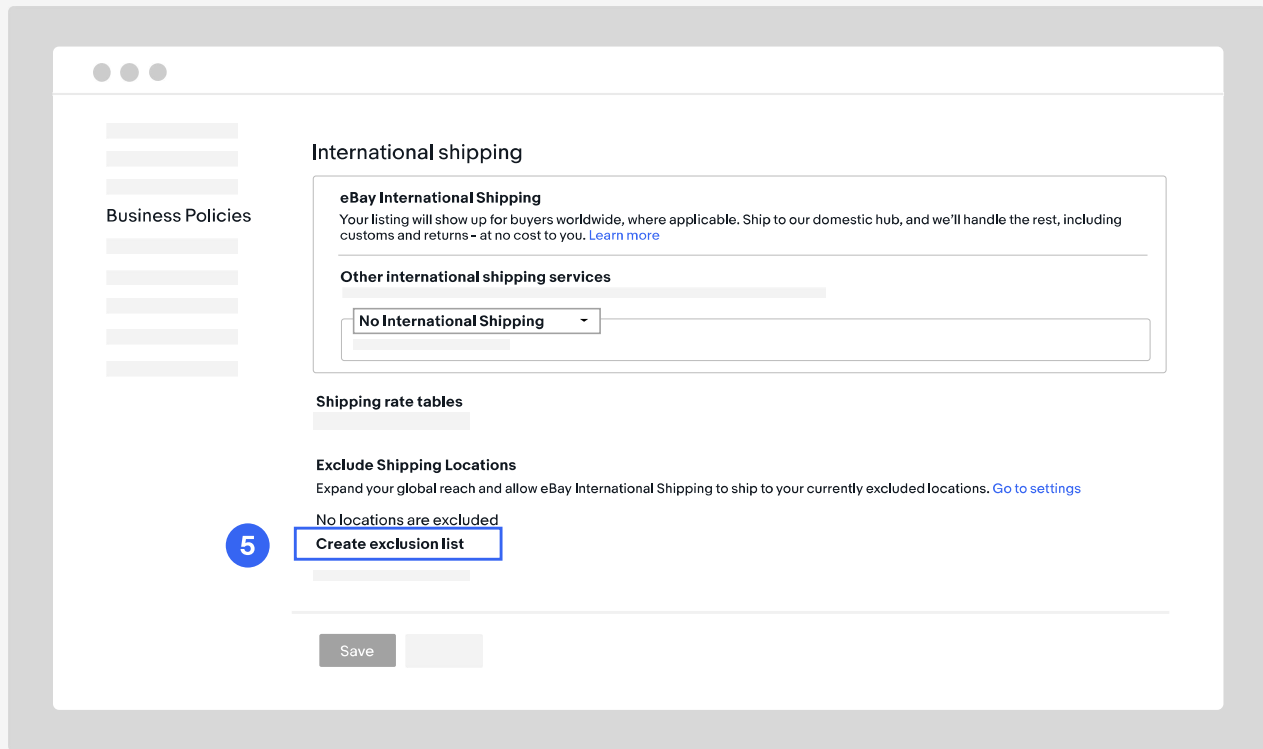

Select a shipping policy you want to revise.

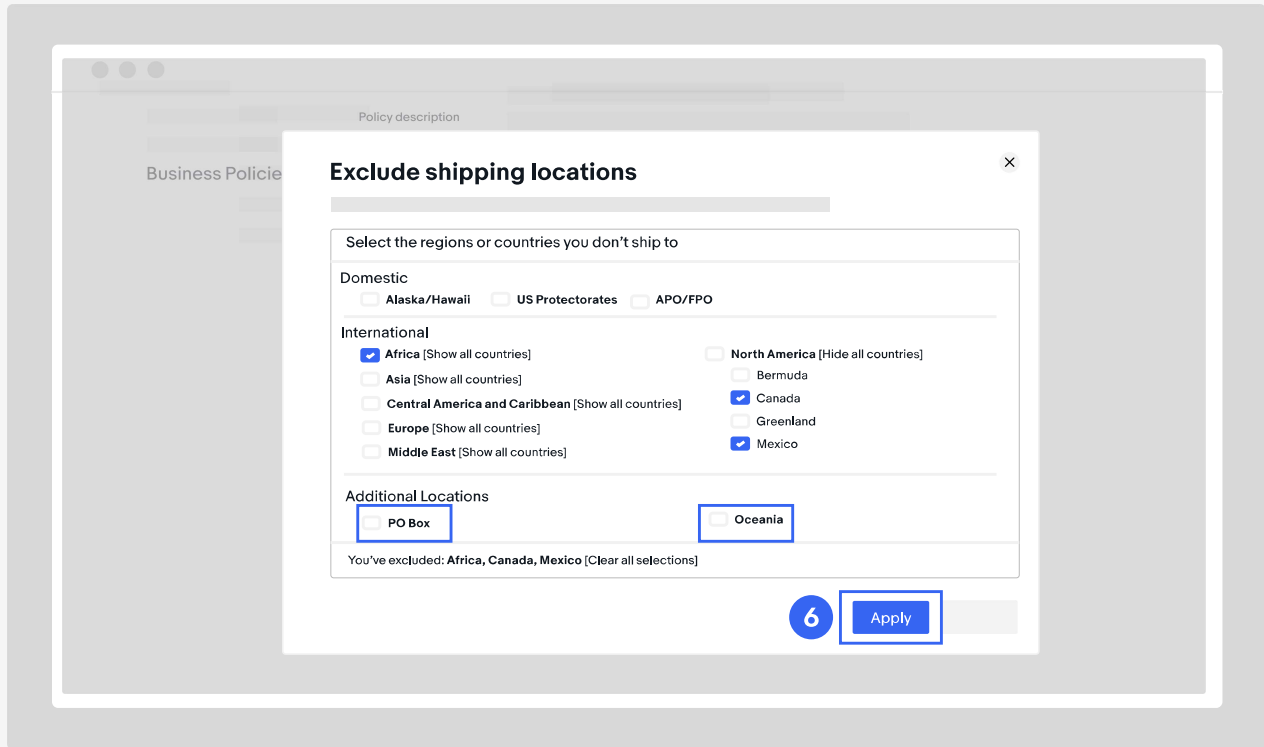

Under the 'International shipping' section, click "Create exclusion list".

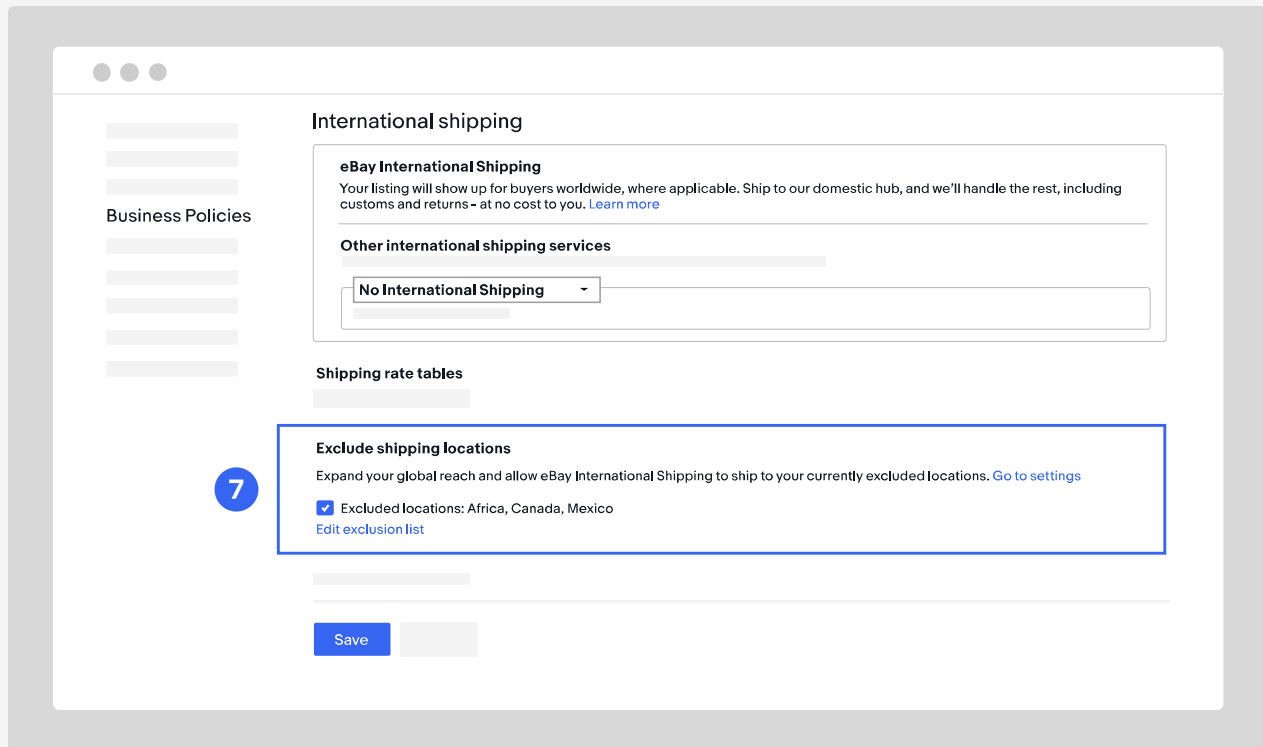

Select all the regions or countries you don't want to ship to. If you don't want to ship to any international locations, select all the boxes. Then, click "Apply."

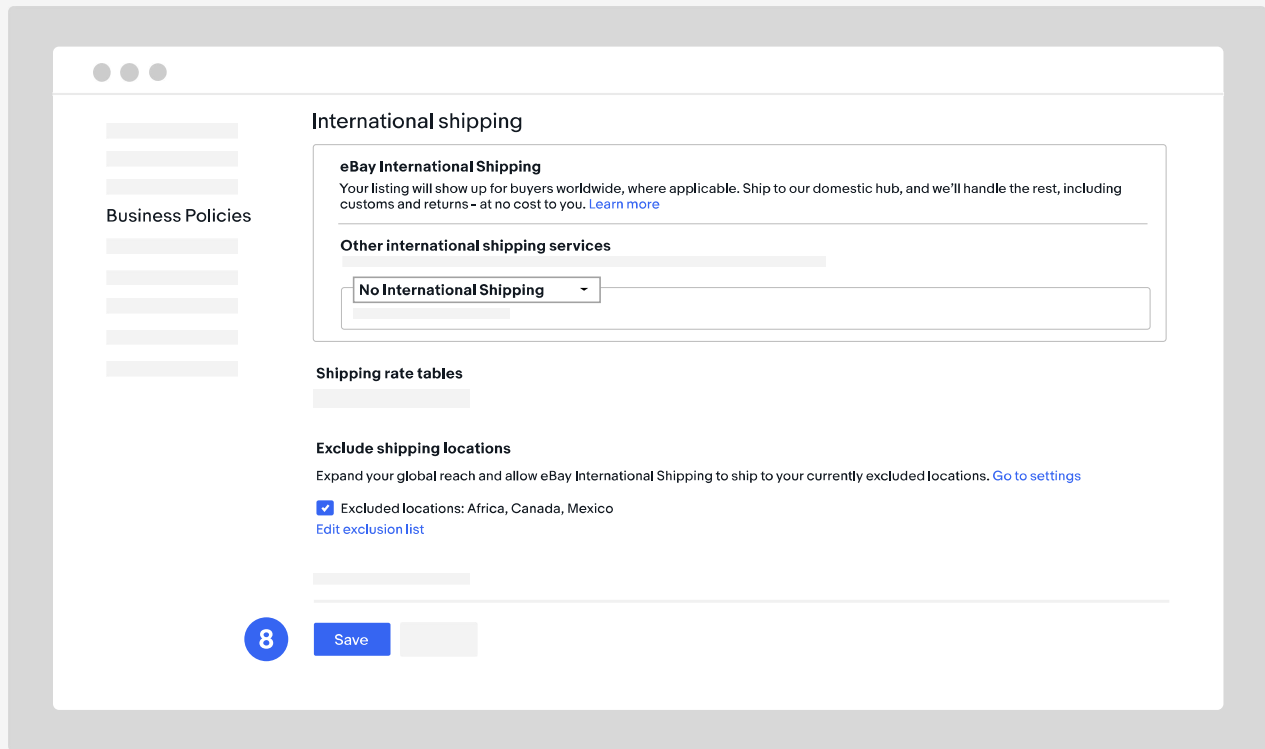
Step 7 (optional)

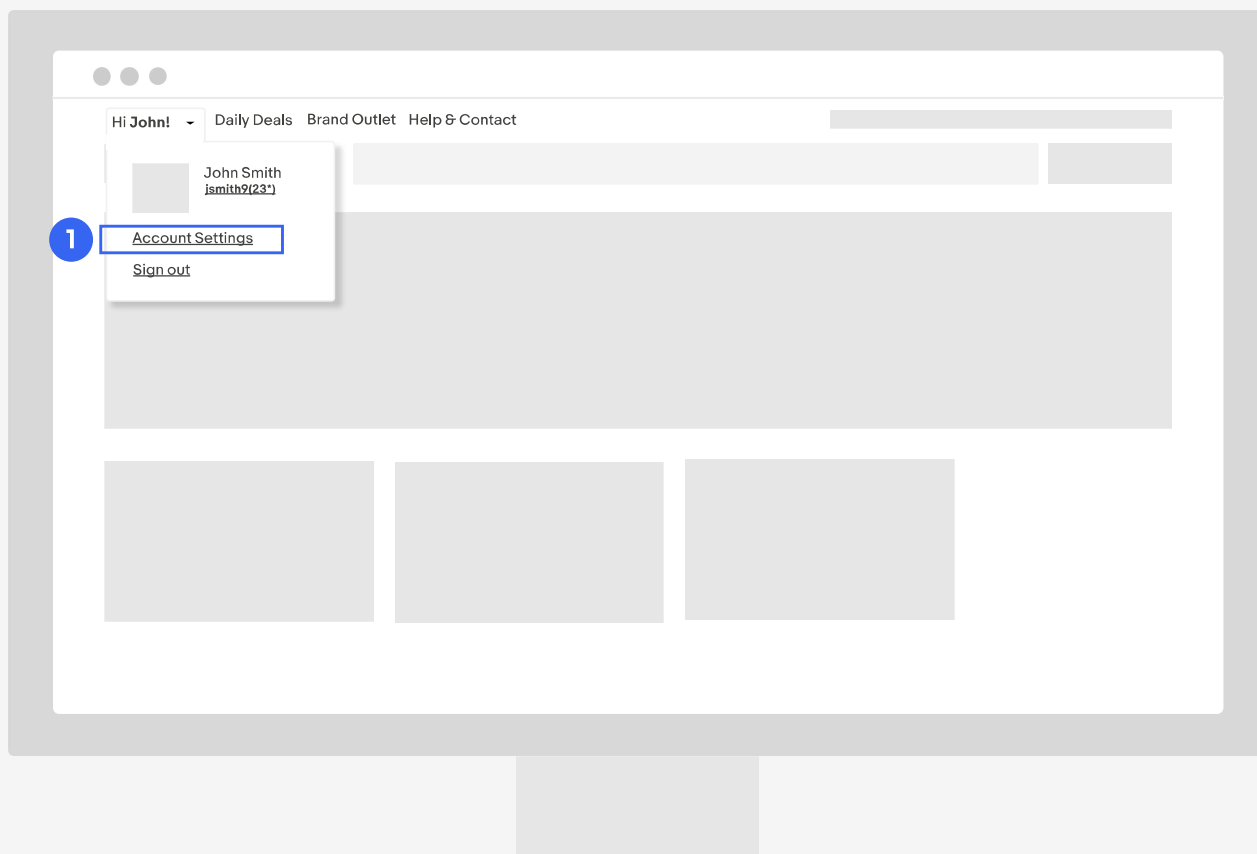

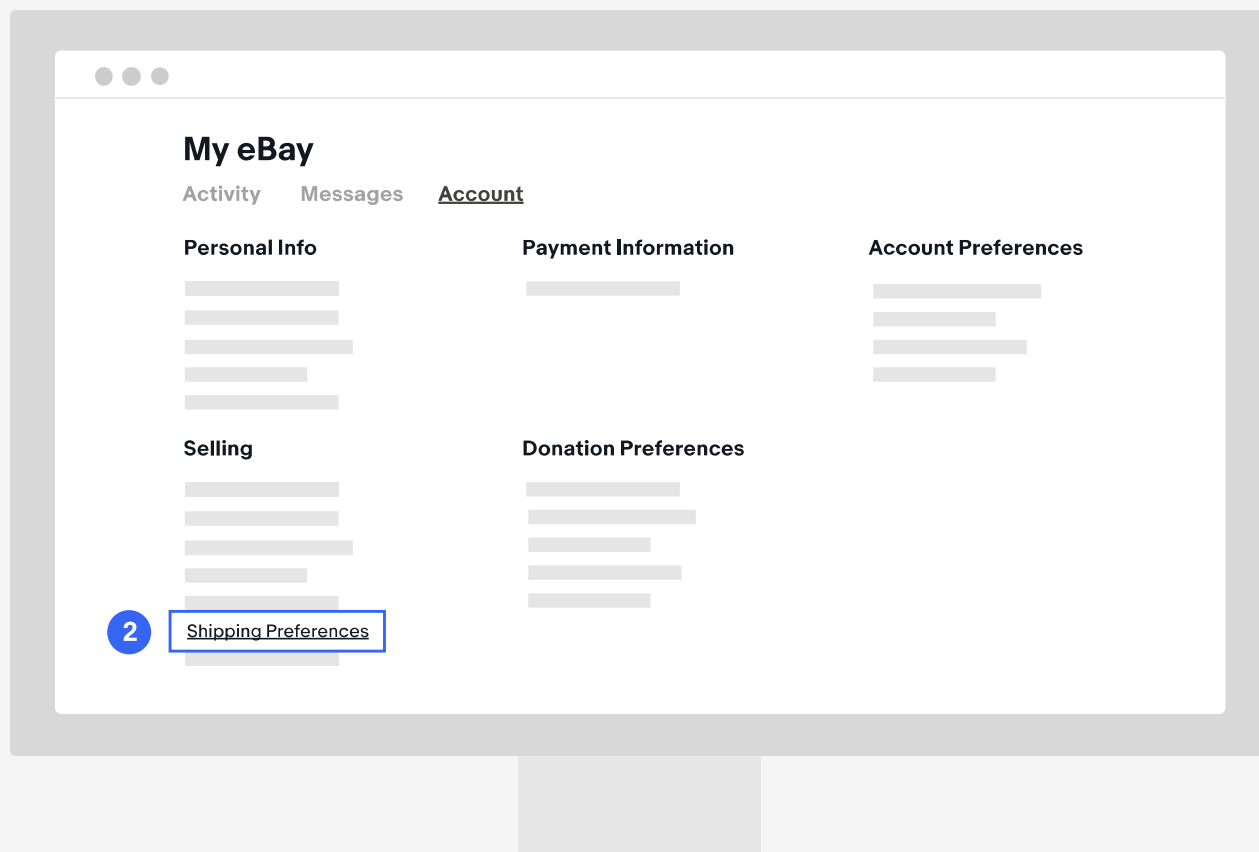

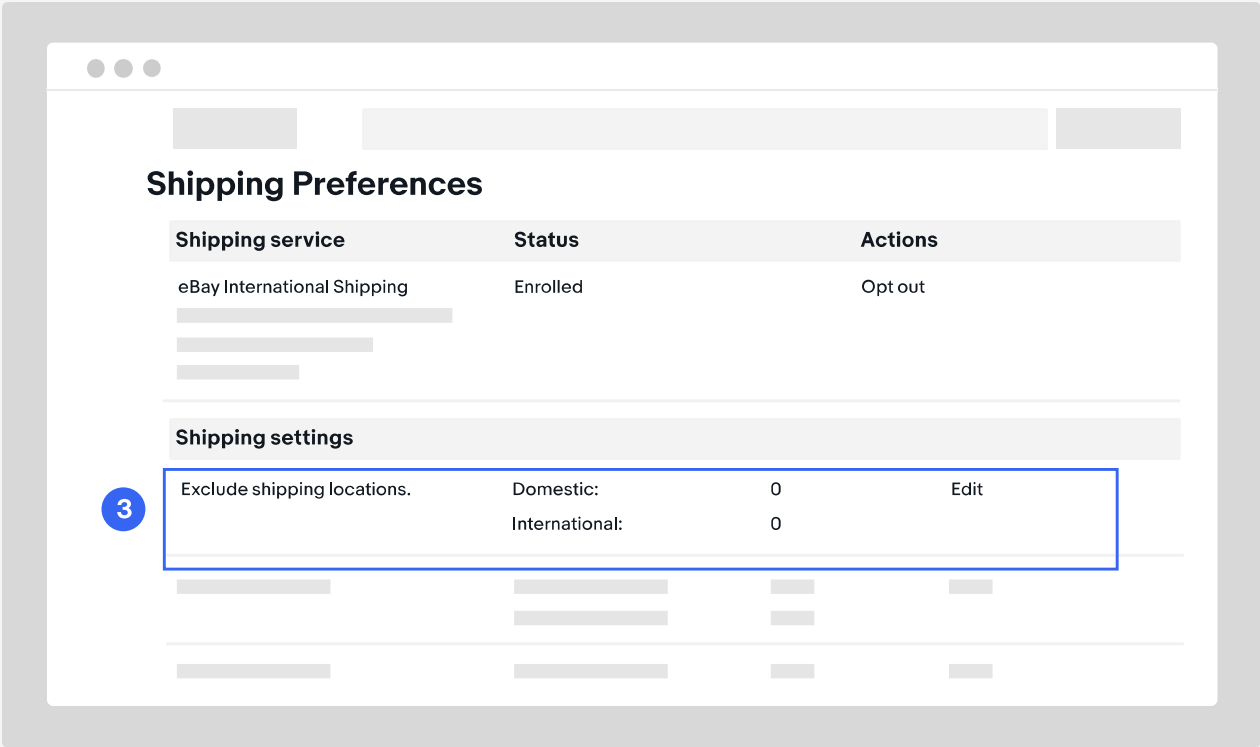

Scroll down and select “Shipping Preferences.”

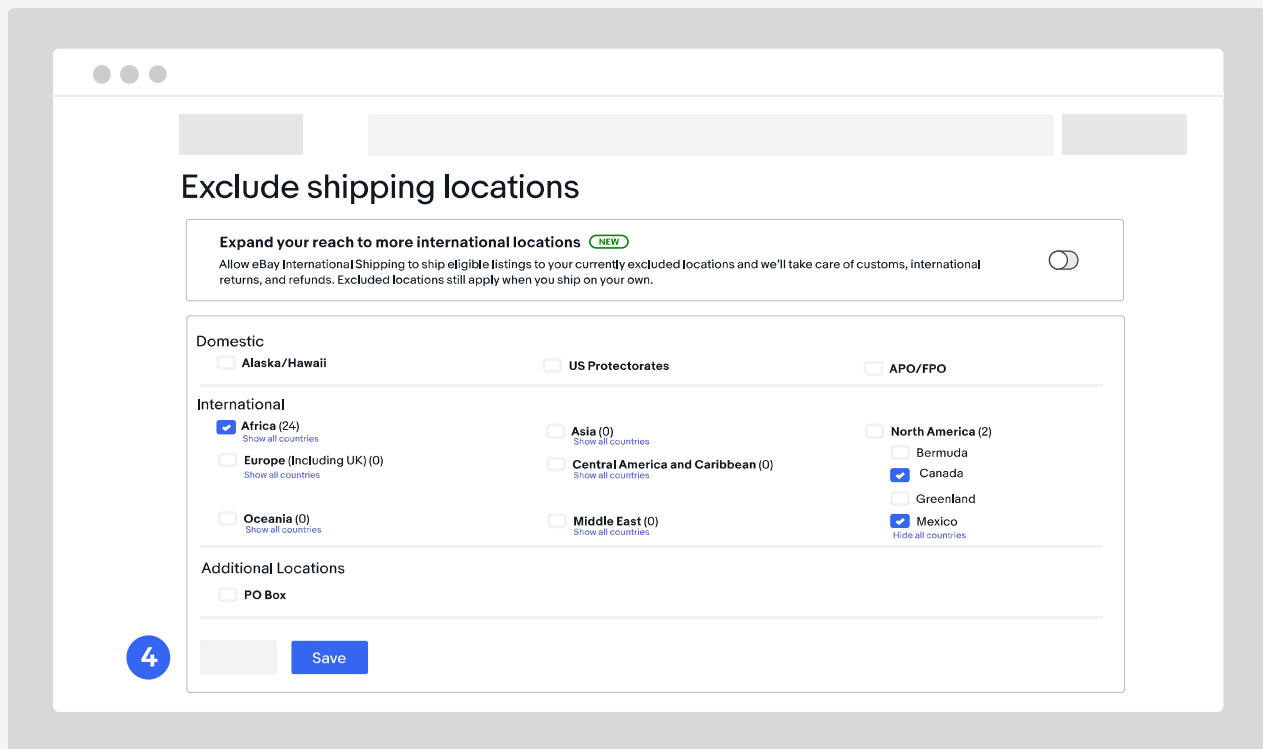

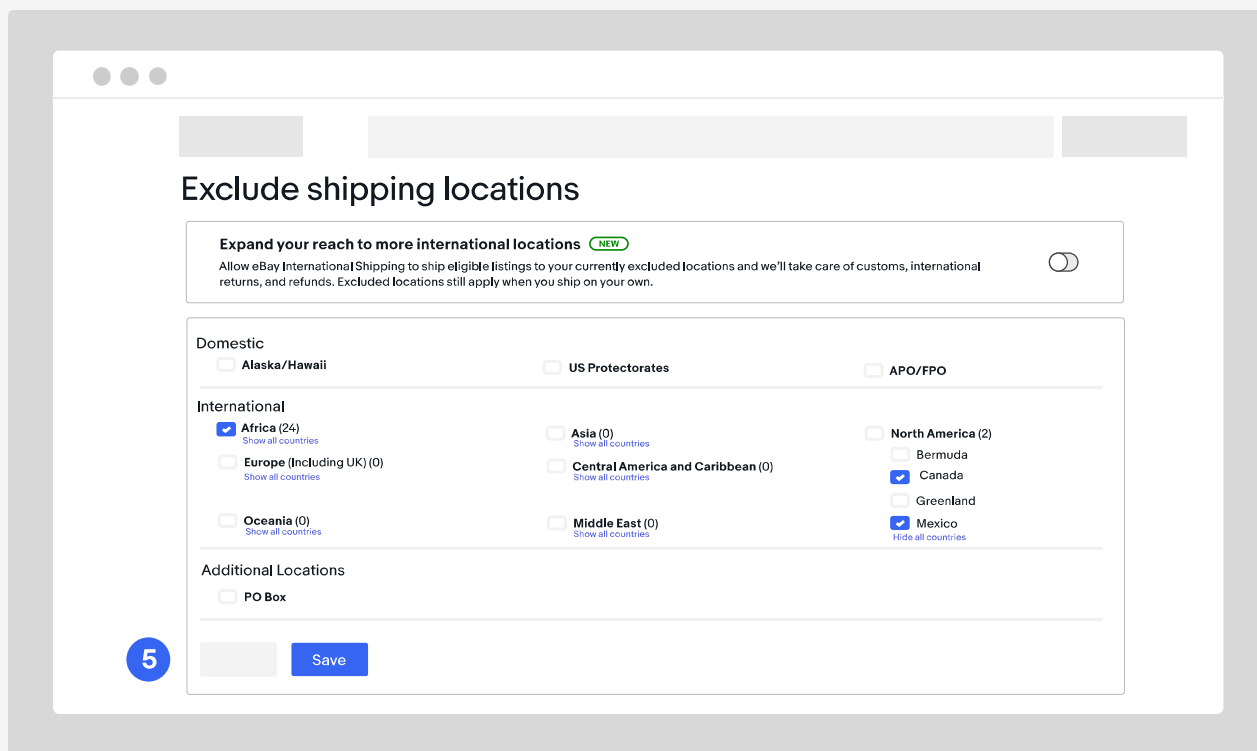


Step 4

Select the regions you want to exclude or click “Show all countries” under certain regions to just exclude individual countries.

If the toggle is off, your exclusions will apply to all of your listings. If the toggle is on, eIS will be offered to your excluded locations, but your self-ship international options will still be excluded.

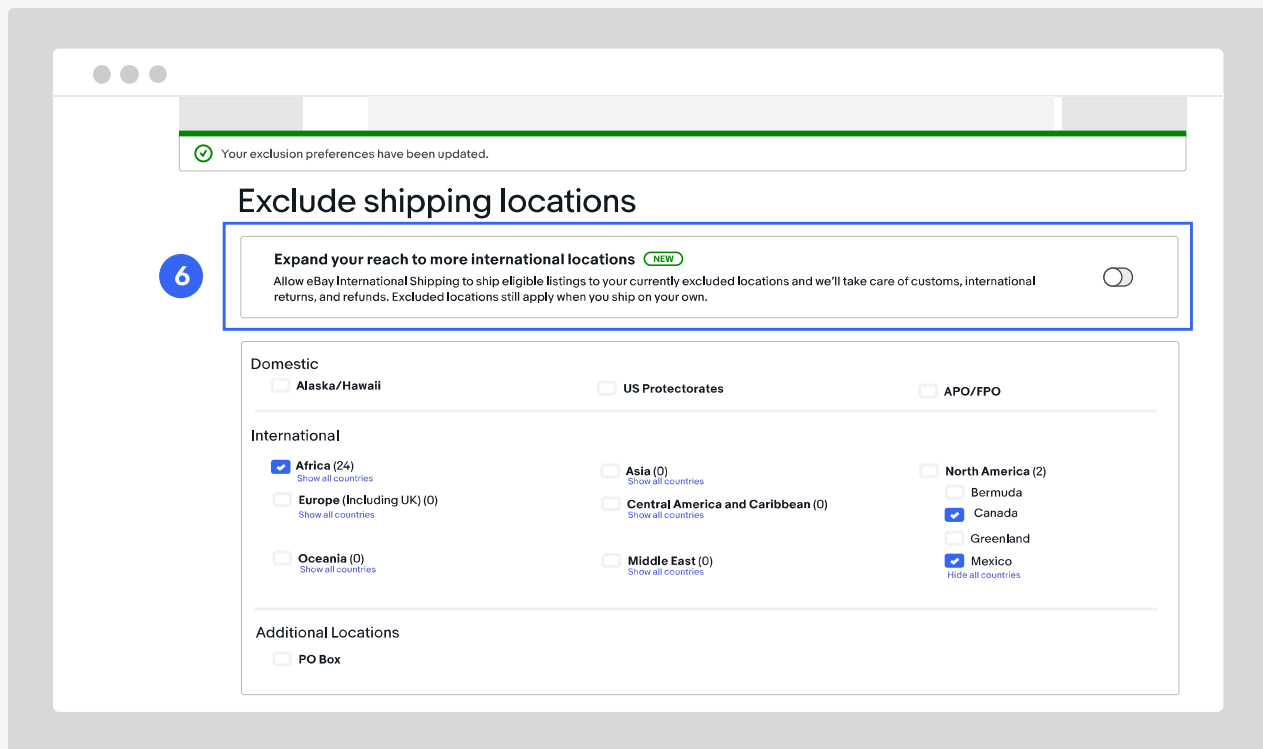

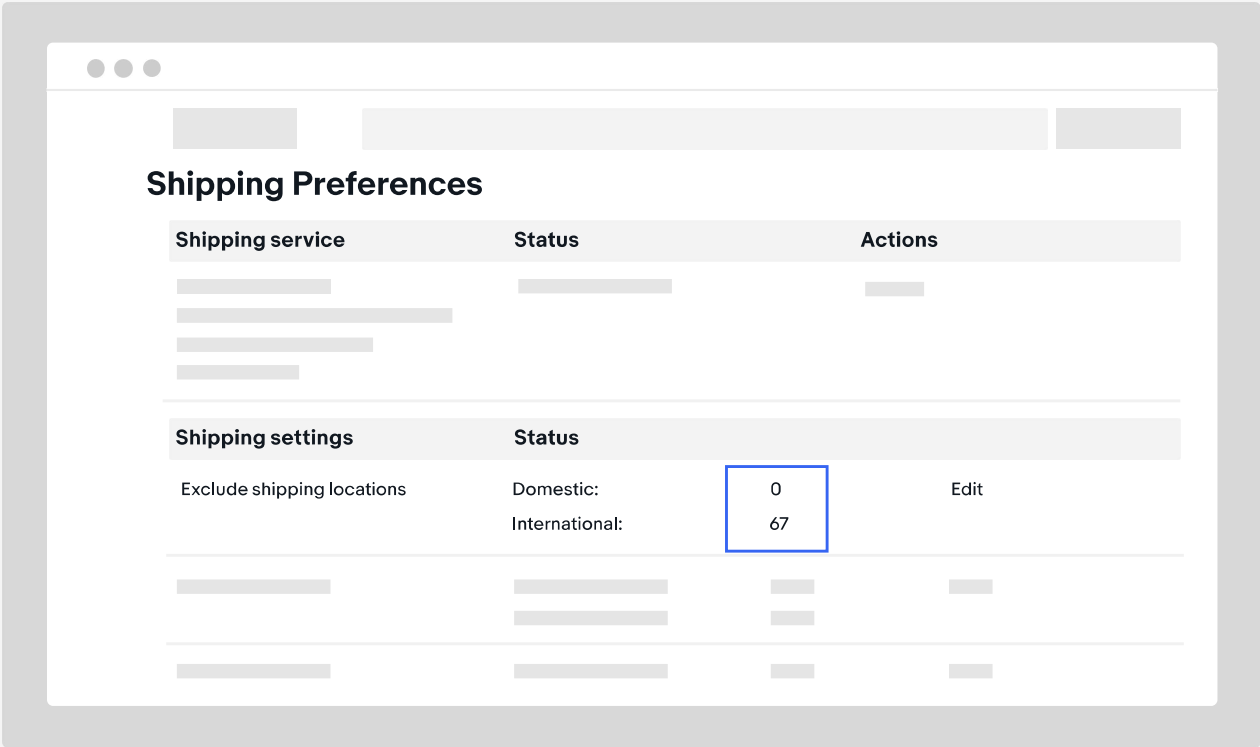
Step 6 (optional)
