

Page 3 Map 3—Cedar Grove camping area and walking tracks; Map 4—Amamoor Creek camping area and walking tracks










Walk and trail classifications





Grade 4 track: Rough track. May be long and very steep with few directional signs. For experienced bushwalkers.

Visit safely



Never dive into creeks or rock pools. Water hazards include submerged rocks and logs. Water depth is variable and unpredictable.




Rock surfaces can be slippery. Take care on walks, especially when crossing creeks. Never cross flooded creeks.
