design;

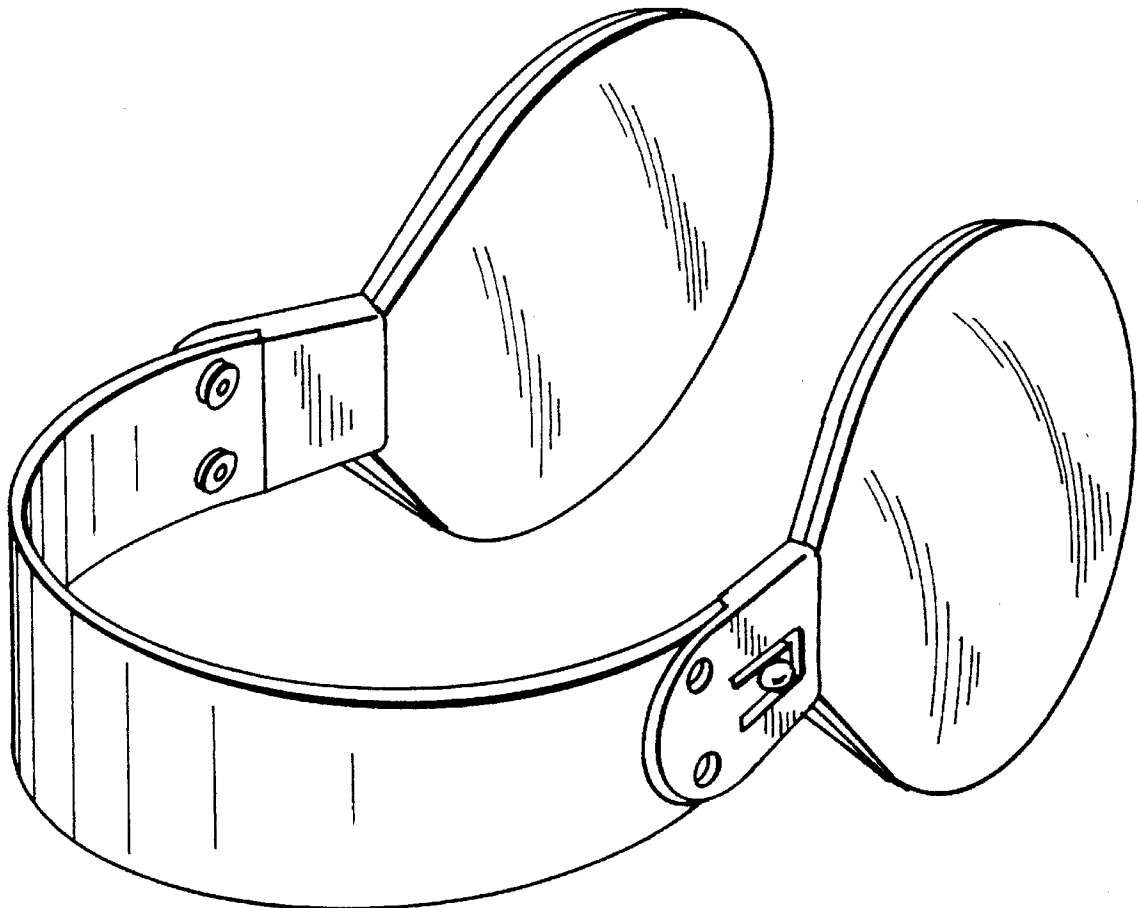

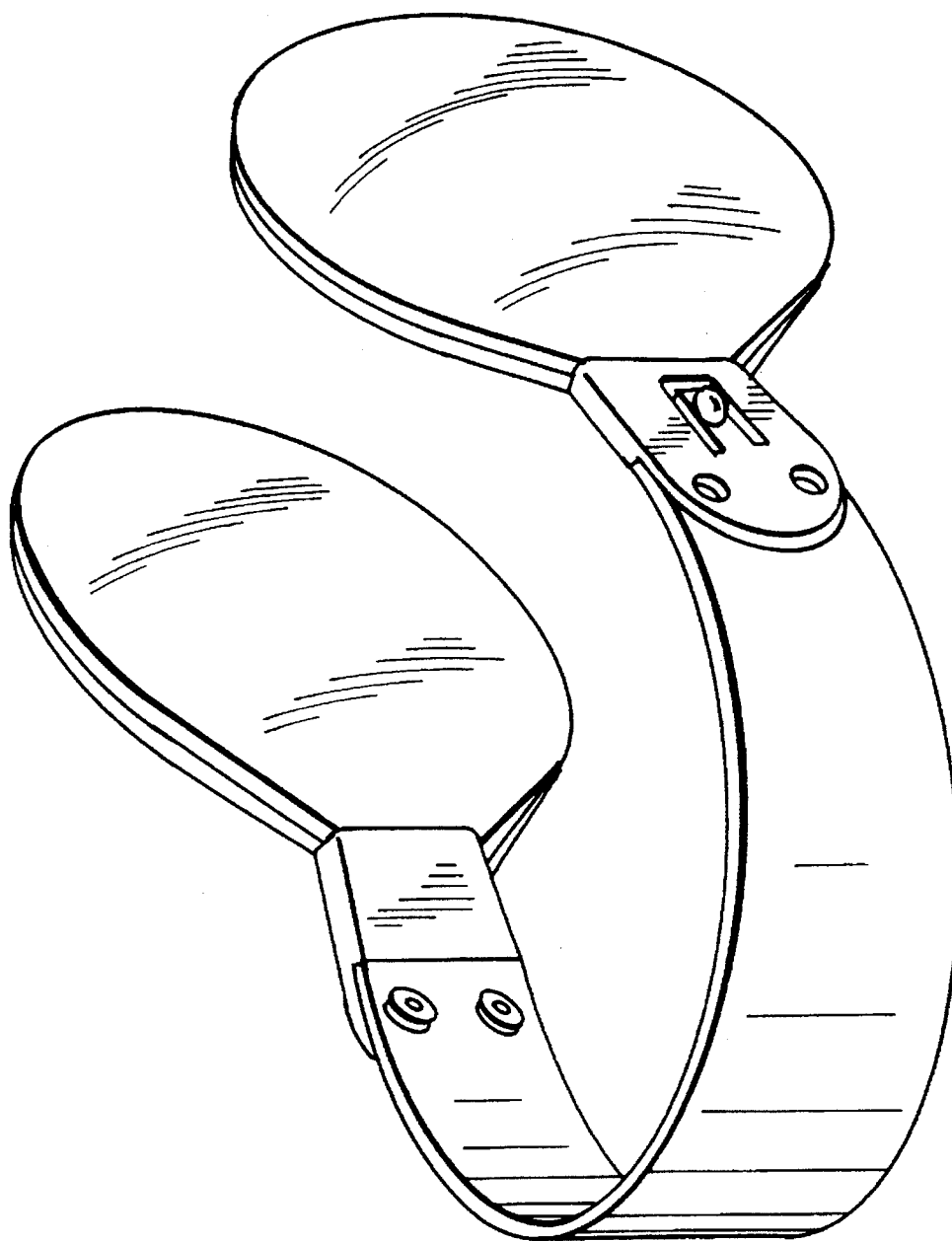

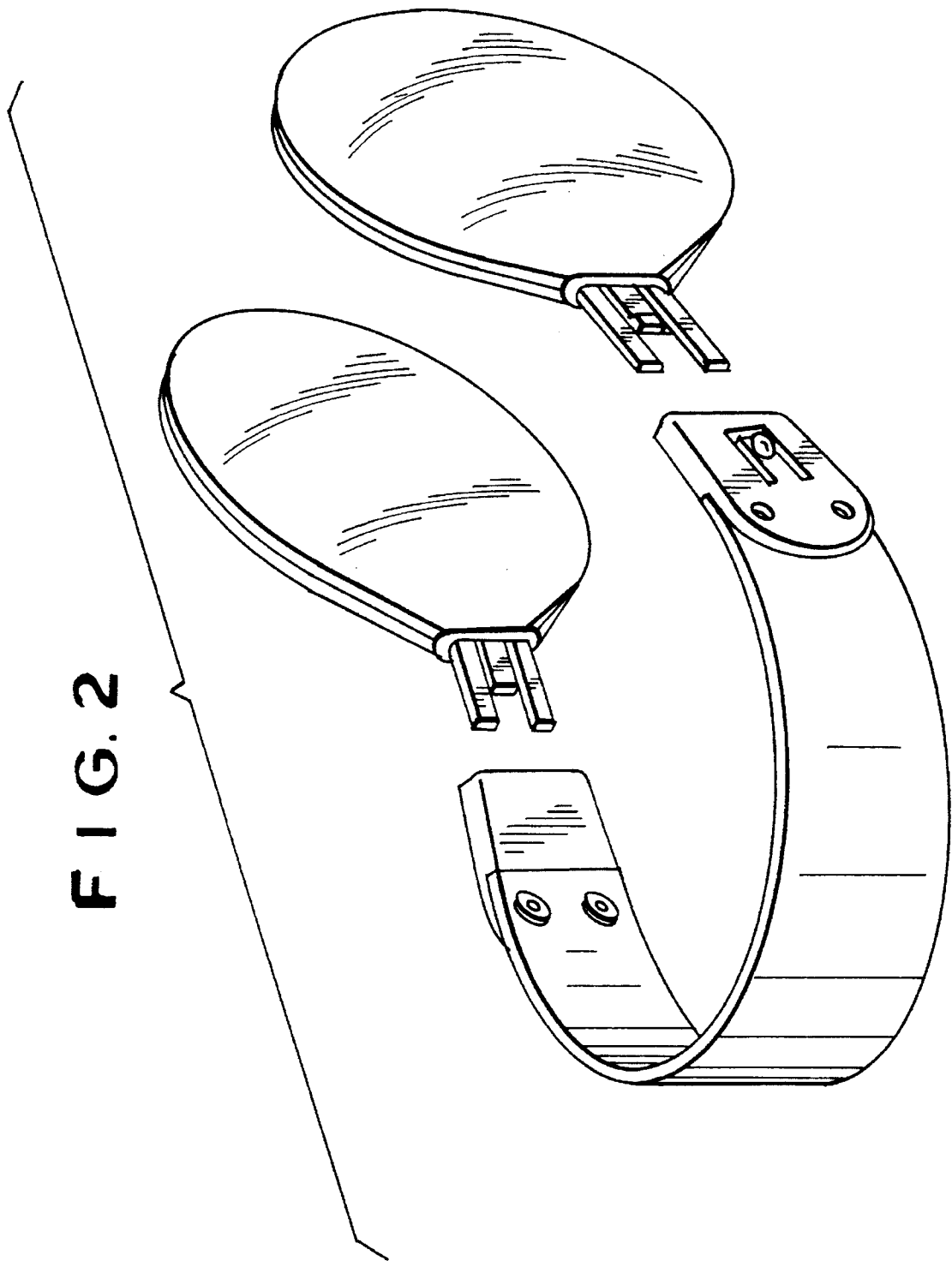
