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
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(54) Title: HYDROXY-SUBSTITUTED BENZOIC ACID AMIDE COMPOUNDS FOR USE IN THERAPY

(57) Abstract: The invention provides the use of a compound for the manufacture of a medicament for the treatment of pain, wherein the compound is a compound of the formula (VI): or a salt, solvate, tautomer or N-oxide thereof; wherein the bicydic group: is selected from the structures (Cl), (C5) and (C6): wherein n, R^1 , R^2 , R^3 , R^4 , R^8 and R^{10} are as defined in the claims. The invention also provides the use of a compound of the formula (VI) for the manufacture of a medicament for the prophylaxis or treatment of a fungal, protozoal, viral or parasitic disease state or condition (other than a disease state or condition due to Plasmodium falciparum) or for use in the prophylaxis or treatment of Ewing's sarcoma, atherosclerosis or lupus erythematosus.
