DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the headband design of this invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof, with the rear view being identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a side view thereof, with the other side being identical thereto.

FIG. 12 is a front view thereof, with the rear view being identical thereto;


FIG. 13 is a bottom view thereof;














