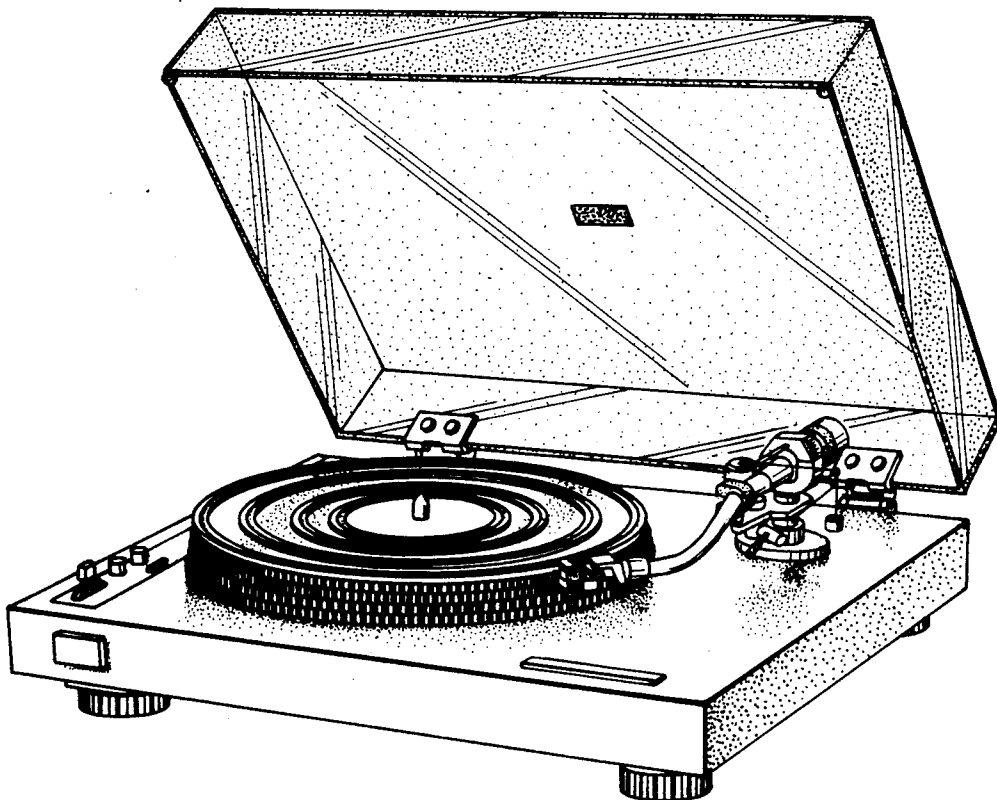

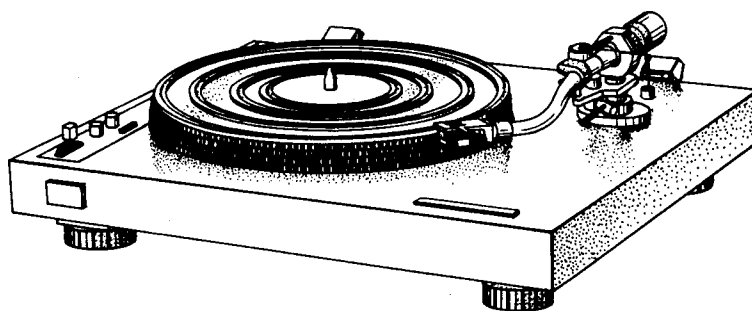
The ornamental design for record player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

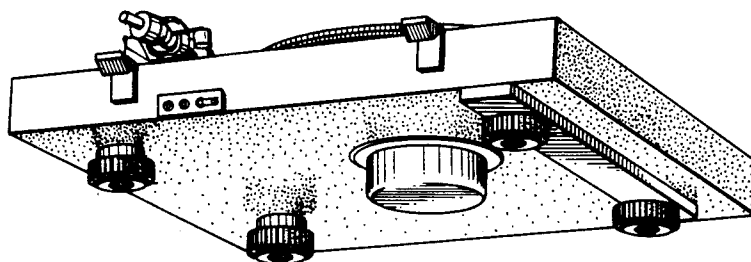
