THE DEPARTMENT OF 19 HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL INCLUDE IN THE REPORT STUDENT 20 ENROLLMENT INFORMATION FOR ELIGIBLE AND NON-ELIGIBLE STUDENTS. 21 DISAGGREGATED BY INCOME, AND SHALL INCLUDE, ONCE THE DATE IS 22 AVAILABLE, DISAGGREGATED OUTCOME MEASURES BY INCOME FOR 23 ELIGIBLE AND NON-ELIGIBLE STUDENTS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO 24 STUDENT RETENTION AND COMPLETION RATES. EACH COLORADO PUBLIC 25 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ANNUALLY REPORT STUDENT 26 LEVEL FINANCIAL AID, STUDENT ELIGIBILITY, AND INCENTIVE ELIGIBILITY 27 INFORMATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT THE 28 DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION DEEMS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE TO 29 THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE FOR INCENTIVE ADMINISTRATION OR FOR 30 INCLUSION IN THE REPORT.".
