

2023 AKC National Tracking Invitational Event Criteria September 9 & 10, 2023 Raymond, NE

The 2023 AKC National Tracking Invitational will be held on September 9 & 10 2023, at Branched Oak State Recreation Area; located at 12000 West Branched Oak Road, Raymond, NE 68428-9728. This event is being jointly hosted by the Cornhusker Kennel Club of Lincoln, Nebraska and the Nebraska Kennel Club of Omaha Nebraska in accordance with the American Kennel Club sponsorship.

The tracks will comply with Chapter 4 of the AKC *Tracking Regulations*, with the following modifications:

Turns: 5-7

Age of Track: 2 – 4 hours

Length of Track: 600 – 800 yards

Articles: 4 (cloth for start article, plastic, metal, and leather)

Cross-tracks: Natural, none plotted

Obstacles: At least two

Surfaces: Variable terrain, cover and surfaces as available. Each track will offer

different scenting challenges such as vehicles, pedestrian and animal

traffic; woods, water and/or non-vegetated surfaces.

Qualifying Period: January 1, 2012 through June 30, 2023

Eligibility: All dogs earning the Champion Tracker (CT) title during the qualifying

period will be invited. Priority will be given in the draw for dogs that have not been exhibited in either the 2013, 2016, 2018 or the 2021 AKC

National Tracking Invitational.

Entry Limits: Entry is limited to 12 dogs.

If more than 12 entries are received, a draw will be conducted in accordance with the *Tracking Regulations*, Chapter 1, Section 17.
