

### DISCOVER THE MAGIC OF SALCOMBE

Salcombe has been a settlement since the Stone Age. Its sheltered position was coveted by Roundheads and Cavaliers during the Civil War. The castle was destroyed on the orders of Oliver Cromwell, depriving the Cavaliers of their last Royalist stronghold. Napoleonic War mock defences can be spotted around the town and it is thought that Napoleon would have liked to be exiled to Salcombe.



When the railway came to Kingsbridge the affluent colonised this picturesque town, famous the world over for its fast fruit schooners.

During the Second World War American servicemen made Salcombe their home and it played an important part in the D-Day landings. The town suffered eleven bombing raids by the Luftwaffe and seventeen civilians lost their lives.

Now a more tranquil town enjoying some of the most stunning landscapes the UK has to offer, Salcombe is in the South Devon Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. It is without doubt the jewel in the crown of the South Hams.

Salcombe's tourist industry thrives year round, particularly during the summer season. As the warmer months roll in, the town becomes a bustling hub of activity, attracting



visitors from all around the globe. The beautiful beaches of South and North Sands are perfect for sunbathing, swimming, and water sports. Boating enthusiasts can take advantage of the harbour's facilities and explore the stunning coastline, dotted with hidden coves and secluded bays teaming with wildlife. Mill Bay and Smalls, both beaches just a short passenger ferry trip across the estuary, are well worth the adventure.

Salcombe and the surrounding areas have a diverse and unique collection of restaurants, pubs and cafes often offering local fish and shellfish alongside locally sourced produce. Salcombe has become a year round destination for many with its fine hotels and huge array of accommodation.

### CELEBRATING 200 YEARS OF THE RNLI

A public art installation covering over 30,000 square metres of fields opposite Salcombe on the banks of the estuary, Salcombe Field of Light will feature an array of 20,000 lowlight, fibreoptic stemmed spheres that will illuminate with a slow subtle change of hue. Visitors will be able to view the art installation from the harbour front in Salcombe or even from

the estuary itself.

Organised by the RNLI, the Field of Light has been donated by the British artist Bruce Munro and made possible by the support of local landowners and businesses. Bruce Munro is best known for producing large lightbased installations which often employ a massing of components by the thousands. His vivid memories of the Salcombe Lifeboat Crew that he met and admired as a teenager working in Salcombe made him keen to realise this iteration of his Field of Light. Bruce says, "To create this installation is a small thank you to the RNLI and their mission 'The RNLI is the charity that saves lives at sea'".

iving in a town that captivates with Lits year-round beauty is not just a privilege; it's a photographer's paradise. As the RNLI celebrates its 200th year, I mark my 50th, with personal celebrations including the London Marathon, a half Ironman, and a full Ironman. Running the London Marathon for the third time will raise funds for the Get A Head Charitable








Trust, a head and neck cancer charity led by my brother, Tom.
