Status quo

- ~17.2M files: **Creative Commons** license
- ~5.7M files: **public domain** assessment
- the remainder have other free license
- ...there are variety of other restrictions

 - **Obligations** (attribution, sharealike)

 - **Author** (Maarten Dammers...)
 - **Attribution text** (Multichill)
 - **Justification** (Own work, Flickr, OTRS)

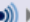

- Restrictions (may be necessary)
 - **Name** (Trademarks, personality rights...)
 - **Identifier** (Q...)

 - ...from these templates:

{{FoP}}	etc...

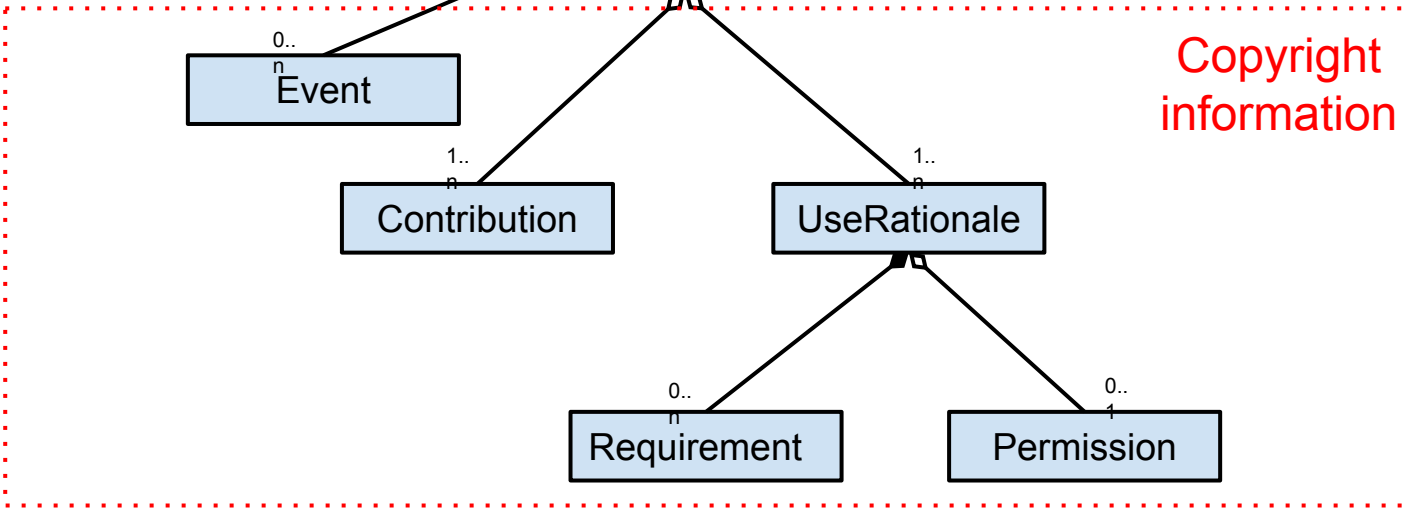
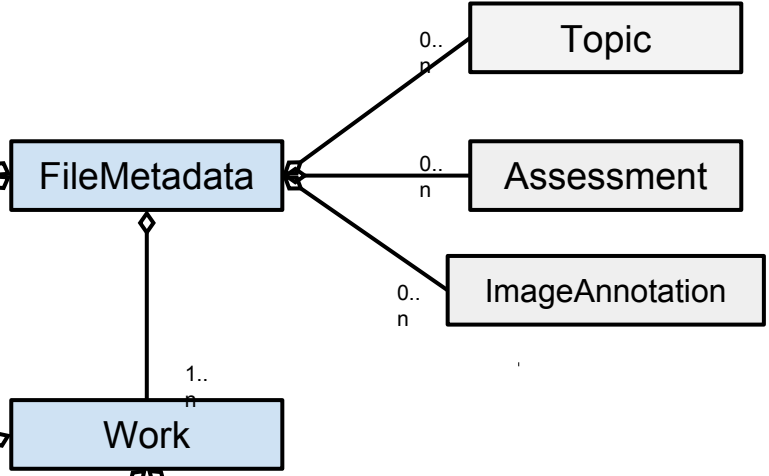
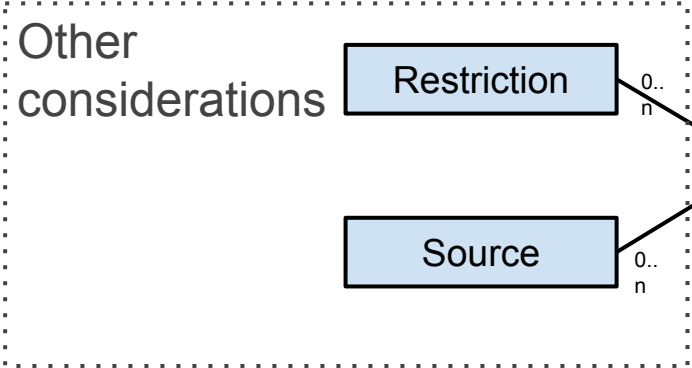
Other considerations *(continued)*

- Source (may be optional, but still significant)
 - ...provides **acknowledgement** even when **attribution** is not required.
