# WELLS

CATHEDRAL SCHOOL

Wells Cathedral School is situated in the rural south west of England. London is 140 miles away and major air, rail and road links are all within easy reach.

## AIR

Bristol Airport is 30 minutes away from Wells and has regular scheduled flights to all parts of the UK and Europe.

## RAIL

The nearest train stations are Bath Spa (40 minutes), Bristol Temple Meads (40 minutes) or Castle Cary (25 minutes).

## BUS

Wells is easily reached by public transport with regular bus services to and from Bath (173) and Bristol (376). National Express coaches travel direct to Heathrow Airport and London, Victoria (National Express 403).

## ROAD

### From London

- From the M4 leave the motorway at Junction 19 (M32). In Bristol follow signs for Wells A37.
- From the M3 leave the motorway at Junction 8 and join the A303 westwards. Follow signs for Warminster (A36), then Frome (A362), then Shepton Mallet (A361) and then Wells (A371).

### From the South West

From the M5 leave the motorway at Junction 23 & join the A39 eastwards following signs for Wells.

### From the West Midlands

From the M5 leave at Junction 20 and take the M4 eastwards and leave the motorway at Junction 19 (M32). In Bristol follow signs for Wells A37.
