### STUDENT WRITING COMPETITION

Every year, AIEN holds a Student Writing Competition for all full-time seniors in a four-year program and all graduate students enrolled at an accredited university. Students are able to choose a topic of their choice that is directly related to international energy negotiations.

Each year, one winner is selected and awarded free registration, transportation to, and hotel accommodations for AIEN's International Energy Summit or Model Contracts Workshop, as well as free membership for one year.

### STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Created in 2009, the AIEN Scholarship Program awards well-qualified students in financial need who possess the potential to make a significant contribution to the field of international energy

negotiations. Scholarships are awarded annually in honor of long-time member and contributor Gordon Barrows.

Each scholarship is in the amount of \$2,000, split \$1,000 for each semester, and paid directly to the winner's university. Scholarship applications are reviewed annually by the student scholarship committee.

Qualified applicants must be AIEN members (or applicants) and may be working toward an energy, commercial, or law degree.

### GUEST SPEAKER PROGRAM

The AIEN Guest Speaker Program assists EAB member schools with finding AIEN members who can speak to their class or AIEN Student Club on oil & gas related topics, and AIEN will assist with travel

### SUMMER ASSISTANTSHIP PROGRAM

Created in 2012, the AIEN Summer Assistantship Program funds up to two, eight or 10-week research positions at participating universities. The program was created to assist students interested in academic summer employment and to assist Education Advisory Board members with their research projects.
