

FROM THE CO-FOUNDER

The actor playing Robert tonight may look familiar to you. Rest assured, when the one-eyed Cuban states, "We're all going to survive tonight, you hear me," I want to believe him.

In the original London production of *The Play That Goes Wrong*, the company, (now called The Cornley Drama Society) was formerly known as The Cornley Polytechnic Drama Society. This hit close to my funny bone, having a certain fondness for the Georgia Institute of Technology and the Southern Polytechnic College of Engineering Technology (at KSU). Both these institutions graduate super smart people. But the humor in this play demonstrates that even when the smartest minds gather to problem solve, evolve, to innovate, and to elevate, we may not be able to fix what is falling down around us.

Each actor in The Murder at Habersham Manor, along with their dedicated technical team, are victims of unfortunate circumstance. Still, they never quit because they have an optimistic belief that their luck will change even though the walls are falling down around them. I, too, believe our luck will change.

The Play That Goes Wrong is a powerful metaphor for what we are experiencing in the creative culture sector. It's not that the arts aren't bringing a lot of patrons to the theatre. Look how FULL our new theatre is. The problem is we don't have "a helping hand," like other industries. The creative industries in Georgia represent \$62.5 billion in total economic impact, but the cultural arts only receive \$1 million of funding for the entire state to drive tourism, to educate and to be vibrant creative place makers. Compare that to agriculture, where we infuse billions of dollars. We pay farmers to produce crops; we pay farmers not to produce crops. We give them tax incentives. I don't know one person who booked a first-class trip to South Georgia to see (or smell) a farm.

So tonight, let's just have FUN. Enjoy the LOVE and LAUGHS we have shared together and know I would never ask if it weren't important, but consider making a gift to ensure that Aurora is able to continue the work we started. This is serious business, and it is no laughing matter.

HENRY LEWIS, **HENRY** SHIELDS. JONATHAN **SAYER** (Playwrights) Henry, Henry, and Jonathan met while training at The London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art (LAMDA). All core members of Mischief Theatre, they had already worked in comedy together for several years before they started out as a writing team. The three's first piece was The Play That Goes Wrong (winner - Best New Comedy - Olivier Awards and What's On Stage Awards). The show started out on the London and Edinburgh fringe before touring the UK and internationally and then returning to the West End in September 2014, where it is still running. It's also playing on Broadway and heading out on a US tour in 2018 and has been performed in over 20 other countries around the world. Peter Pan Goes Wrong was the trio's second piece, opening in November 2014 for a UK tour before a hugely successful West

End season in Christmas 2015. Henry, Henry, and Jonathan recently adapted the script of "Peter Pan Goes Wrong" for the BBC, which was filmed with the original West End cast and broadcast to rave reviews on New Year's Eve. They were invited back to wreak more havoc at the BBC in 2017 with "Christmas Carol Goes Wrong" on BBC1. 




