

2018 Alumni Survey Results Responses Matched to Board Ends Statements (Institutional Learning Outcomes)

1.0-1.1

The Alumni Office sent a survey to the one- and five-year graduates in July 2018. Of 96 surveys sent out, 22 were returned. Graduates were asked to identify how much their education at Calvary contributed to their personal growth in the following areas: (1 = Very Little Contribution, 5 = Much Contribution)

- Living according to a biblical worldview: 4.59 average of 22 responses
- Foundational understanding of the Holy Scripture and Calvary's Doctrinal Statement: 4.86 average of 22 responses

1.2

The Alumni Office sent a survey to the one- and five-year graduates in July 2018. Of 96 surveys sent out, 22 were returned. Graduates were asked to identify how much their education at Calvary contributed to their personal growth in the following areas: (1 = Very Little Contribution, 5 = Much Contribution)

- Understanding emerging philosophies and being able to biblically confront them: 4.41 average of 22 responses
- Operating effectively in the world: 4.09 average of 22 responses
- Effectively relating to others: 4.18 average of 22 responses

Also according to this survey (of the ones reporting):

- 9 alumni say their current job is directly related to their major area of study at Calvary;
- 5 alumni say their current job is somewhat related to their major area of study at Calvary;
- 8 alumni say their current job is not at all related to their major area of study at Calvary.

- Thinking critically and analytically: 4.50 average of 22 responses

According to the survey sent out by the Alumni Office to the one- and five-year graduates, our alumni are effectively prepared for continued learning.

- Of 96 surveys sent out in July 2018, 22 were returned. Graduates were asked to identify how much their education at Calvary contributed to their personal growth in the following areas: (1 = Very Little Contribution, 5 = Much Contribution)

- Writing effectively: 4.09 average of 22 responses
- Speaking effectively: 3.91 average of 22 responses
- Developing mature study habits: 4.41 average of 22 responses
- Planning and carrying out projects: 4.18 average of 22 responses
- Organizing time effectively/time management: 4.14 average of 22 responses

Also on the survey, graduates were asked to indicate their level of agreement with the following statement: (1 = Disagree, 5 = Agree)

- My education at Calvary effectively prepared me for continued learning: 4.55 average of 22 responses³
- Also on the survey, graduates were asked if they have continued their education since graduating from Calvary. Out of 22 responses, 12 alumni said they have continued their education.

The Alumni Office sent a survey to the one- and five-year graduates in July 2018. Of 96 surveys sent out, 22 were returned. Graduates were asked to identify how much their education at Calvary contributed to their personal growth in the following area: (1 = Very Little Contribution, 5 = Much Contribution)

- Recognizing the importance of the local church in the program of God: 4.41 average of 22 responses

Also on the survey, graduates were asked if they are currently attending a local church. Out of 22 responses, 21 alumni said they are attending a local church. 1 alumnus is not currently attending.

The Alumni Office sent a survey to the one- and five-year graduates in July 2018. Of 96 surveys sent out, 22 were returned. Graduates were asked to identify how much their education at Calvary contributed to their personal growth in the following area: (1 = Very Little Contribution, 5 = Much Contribution)

- Seeking and obeying the will of God in making life choices: 4.68 average of 22 responses

Also according to this survey (of the ones reporting):

- 5 alumni say they are currently involved in full-time, paid ministry;
- 1 alumnus says he is currently involved in part-time, paid ministry;
- 14 alumni say they are currently involved in volunteer, unpaid ministry;
- 1 alumnus says he is not currently involved in ministry.

The Alumni Office sent a survey to the one- and five-year graduates in July 2018. Of 96 surveys sent out, 22 were returned, 2 of which were seminary alumni. Graduates were asked to identify how much their education at Calvary contributed to their personal growth in the following areas: (1 = Very Little Contribution, 5 = Much Contribution)

- Comprehension of the dispensational approach in the interpretation of the Scripture: 4.50 average of 2 Seminary alumni responses
- A biblical and theological foundation for ministry and study: 5.00 average of 2 Seminary alumni responses
- Biblical philosophy of ministry: 5.00 average of 2 Seminary alumni responses

Also on the survey, graduates were asked to indicate their level of agreement with the following statement: (1 = Disagree, 5 = Agree)

- My education and related experiences at Calvary (Christian Ministries and other activities) prepared me to minister in my area of study: 4.59 average of 22 responses
