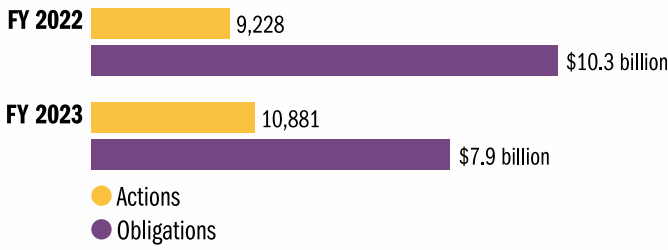


Office of Financial Resources (OFR): FY 2023 Acquisition Snapshot at CDC

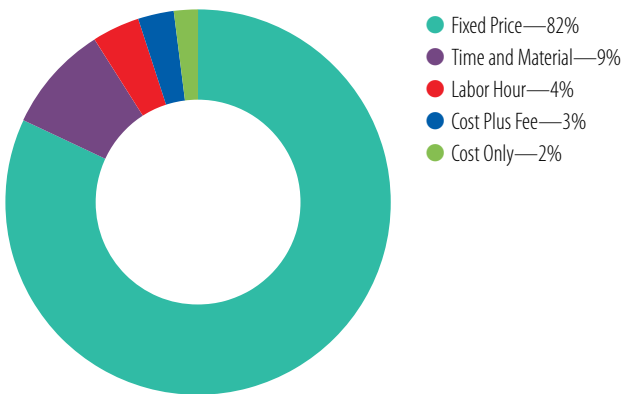
CDC fulfilled 25,205 acquisition and assistance actions in FY 2023, obligating more than \$20.5 billion in federal funds. This allowed public health funds to quickly and effectively reach intended populations to maximize public health outcomes.

Of the 25,205 acquisition and assistance actions obligating more than \$20.5 billion in FY 2023, OFR processed 10,881 contract actions totaling \$7.9 billion through its Office of Acquisition Services in support of public health programs and research in the United States and around the world.

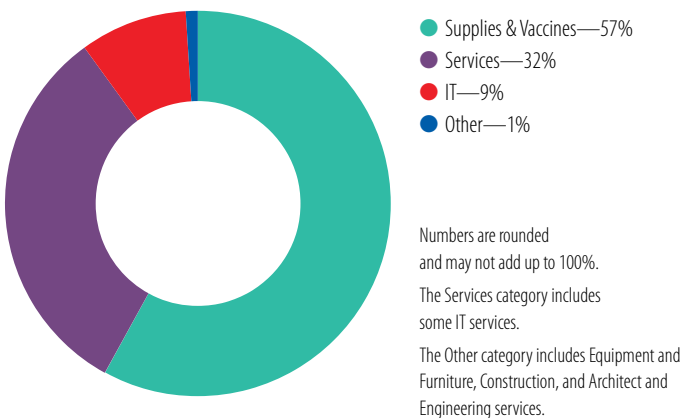
FY 2022–2023 Comparison of Contract Actions and Obligations

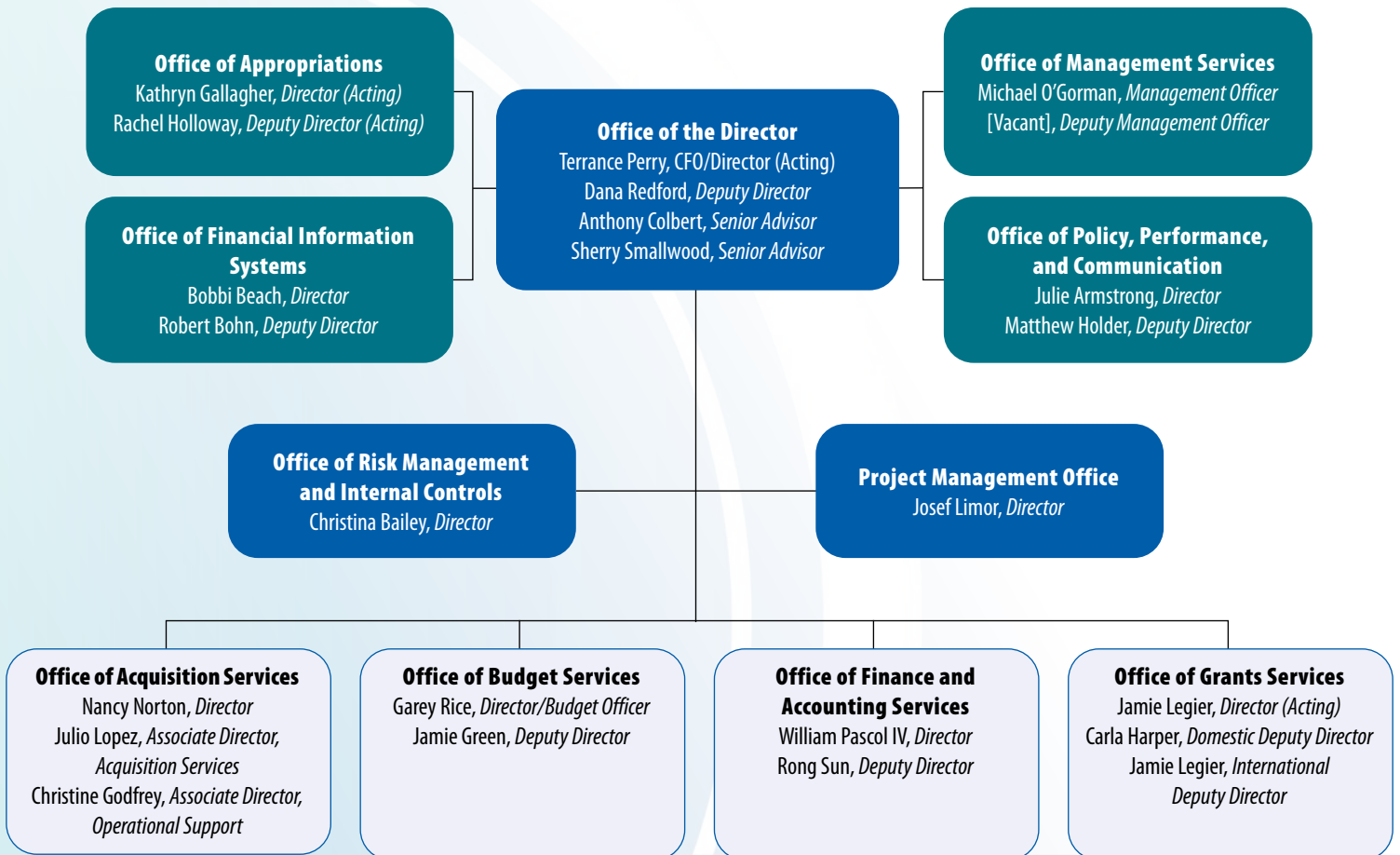
