How Adaptive Design Works Detailed Demographic and Housing Characteristics File A (Detailed DHC-A)

The 2020 Census produced data for nearly 1,500 detailed race and ethnic groups and detailed American Indian and Alaska Native (AIAN) tribes and villages—the most in U.S. Census Bureau history.

Total population and sex by age data were released in the Detailed DHC-A. To protect individuals' confidential census responses, different levels of sex by age data were published for different groups. Using a process called "adaptive design," the differentially private estimate of the size of the detailed race and ethnicity groups and AIAN tribes and villages at the geographic levels below determine whether the group receives a total population count only or whether it also receives sex by age data.¹

Detailed Groups:

Detailed groups include individual race, ethnicity, and AIAN tribes and villages.

Examples of detailed groups include German, Lebanese, Mexican, Jamaican, Nigerian, Chinese, the Navajo Nation, Samoan, Brazilian, etc.
