The Faculty Fellowship Publication Program (FFPP) is a faculty development and mentoring program that advances CUNY's institutional commitment to diversity. Sponsored by University Human Resources, this university-wide initiative assists full-time CUNY faculty in the design and execution of writing projects essential to progress toward tenure and promotion. These projects may include research-based scholarly articles for juried journals, books for academic presses, and grant proposals. This signature program provides three credit hours of course release for the spring semester, a writing group, and the guidance of a senior faculty member. Proposals on structural and systemic inequality are encouraged.

PROGRAM PURPOSE & DESCRIPTION

The Faculty Fellowship Publication Program (FFPP), sponsored by University Human Resources, is a faculty development and mentorship program aimed at the retention and advancement of CUNY tenure-track faculty. For over twenty-five years, the FFPP has met CUNY's institutional commitment to diversity by assisting a wide-ranging population of full-time faculty in the design and execution of their writing projects. Essential for tenure and promotion, these projects include research-based scholarly articles for juried journals, books for academic presses, creative writing projects as well as grant proposals. Applications that focus on structural and systemic inequality are encouraged. The FFPP provides three credit hours of course release for the spring semester, a writing group, and the guidance of a senior faculty member.

For the 2024-2025 academic year, FFPP Proposals are being accepted from eligible faculty in the following disciplines:

- Creative Writing/Film
- Education
- Humanities
- Public Health
- Race, Ethnic, and Gender Studies
- Social Sciences
- STEM

FFPP ELIGIBILITY

- The faculty member may not have been a past participant.
- Applicants are welcome to apply to other CUNY mentoring initiatives, but if accepted to multiple programs, they will be eligible for only one.
- Be an untenured assistant or associate professor, or tenured assistant professor.
- Be reappointed for the 2024-25 academic year.
- Have a doctorate or required terminal degree for teaching in the applicant's discipline (e.g., MFA for faculty in creative writing and/or film programs).

• Agree to attend all writing sessions and related activities, including the FFPP Orientation (Fall 2024) and the Professional Development Day (Spring 2025).

FFPP SUBMISSION DEADLINE & NOTIFICATION DATES

Submission deadline: On or before Friday, October 25, 2024

Notification of decision: Friday November 22, 2024

FFPP PROPOSAL REVIEW & EVALUATION CRITERIA

The following parameters are considered when reviewing and evaluating FFPP Proposals:

- The overall quality, organization and clarity of the proposal
- The relevance and impact of the proposal to the applicant's discipline
- Prior work that demonstrates scholarly achievement
- Significance of the proposal to diversity, equity, and inclusion in higher education

1. FFPP Proposal Cover Sheet providing:

- Applicant name, rank, campus, department, and proposal title
- Date of initial full-time appointment
- Contact information

2. FFPP Proposal Components

- Proposal Title
- Abstract, 100 words
- **Proposal Narrative**, 750 to 1000 words
- **Diversity Statement**, 250 words, discussing a) your efforts to foster diversity in the academy through scholarship, creative projects, or work with students or faculty; and b) the potential for your FFPP project to expand and diversify the existing intellectual horizon.
- A current Curriculum Vitae, and

• **Two Letters**, one from your department chair and one from your provost, supporting reassignment of three of your contractual teaching hours in the spring 2025 term to allow for your participation in the program. FFPP provides funding to campuses for those reassigned teaching hours.
