<b>Contract Number:</b>	4400032468
<b>Contract Period:</b>	August 7, 2023 - August 6, 2025
<b>Eligibility:</b>	Any state agency, political subdivision, county government, municipal government or other entity authorized to use state contracts.

### Quotes and Purchase Orders:

Quotes are valid for 30 days from the creation date of the quote **OR** until the contract expires, whichever occurs first.

To obtain a quote, contact your local [John Deere Dealer](#). Submit purchase order to your local dealer. The John Deere Dealer will submit the purchase order to John Deere's Government Sales office

All purchase orders must show Deere & Company as the vendor and reference the contract number.

## Contract Details

Delivery Obligations	<p><b><u>Equipment Transport</u></b></p> <p>Each unit shall be provided with the following:</p> <p>The operating weight of the unit (in pounds) as delivered, including standard equipment and all specified options and with full fluid capacities, shall be stenciled by the entity installing the mower in two-inch-high black letters/numerals on each side of the machine in a conspicuous location. Four (4) tie-down points for safely securing the unit during trailer transport. One (1) tie-down point shall be located as close as practicable to each of the unit's lower four (4) corners. The tie-down points shall have an aggregate rated strength of at least one and one-half times the unit's gross weight. If lashing (D) rings are provided on the tractor, the rings shall accommodate a ½ inch (13mm), grade 80, grab hook. The weight centerline, computed with full fuel tank and mower in transport position, without operator, shall be clearly marked by the entity installing the mower on each side of the unit with a green vertical line approximately 3 inches wide and 5 inches high. (This is for safe loading on trailers). When tractors are purchased without mowers, the tractor manufacturer/supplier is responsible for complying with these requirements. Weight and centerline is required on tractor only purchases, as well as tie-downs.</p> <p><b><u>Training</u></b></p>
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	<p>In conjunction with delivery of the first unit, the dealer shall conduct a minimum one-day school on the safety, operation, maintenance, and diagnostics of the unit by factory trained expert personnel at the ordering entity's facility in South Carolina. In addition, and for each unique subsequent unit, the dealer will conduct a minimum one-day school in the county where the unit is to be assigned, as applicable, with the using governmental unit's operator(s) and service personnel, after the equipment has been delivered to the county where it is to be assigned.</p> <p><b><u>Tractor Specifications</u></b></p> <p>The unit shall be complete with LED warning lights. Warning lights should power "on" when equipment is turned on and must meet SAE J595 Class 1 or SAE J845 Class 1 certified. Tractors shall be equipped with a with brush guard for above cab strobe mounted above top rear of Roll-Over Protection Structure (ROPS) cab to provide 360-degree visibility. Tractors shall be equipped with a Slow-Moving Vehicle (SMV) Identification Emblem, meeting requirements of most recent SAE J-943 standard and mounted in accordance with the standard. Tractors shall be equipped with a Back-up alarm 107 db. minimum. The tractor will have a radio power circuit installed from battery to inside operator cab.</p>
Fees	<p><b>Delivery Charge</b> An optional delivery charge of \$6.00 per loaded mile is allowed for the delivering dealer. This fee is <u>not</u> per machine; it's per load. The agency must agree to the fee. If charged, the fee must appear as a separate line item on the quote or purchase order. Use <a href="#">Google Maps</a> to calculate the mileage.</p>
Financing	<p><b>Not Allowed.</b> Contract prohibits financing.</p>
Machine Hours	<p><b>Not Allowed:</b> Due to factory delivery, pre-delivery inspection, machine setup and installation of attachments, machines may have minimal hours. Machines designated as demos are not allowed.</p>
Manuals	<p>Service literature shall include (as one set) an operator's instruction manual, illustrated repair parts manual, and shop overhaul manual. Electronic (CD, DVD, or Internet) format is preferred (documents in .pdf format) and should be furnished when available, except for the equipment operator manual that stays with the equipment. This service literature shall be complete and cover the entire unit, to include engines and transmissions.</p> <p>Dealers shall be reimbursed for manuals.</p>
Multiple Unit Discount	<p>Sales of 3 or more like self-propelled products sold on the same purchase order are eligible for the multi-unit discount. The 3 or more self-propelled products must be in the same equipment categories as shown below and included on the same purchase order. Compatible implements sold with such products also qualify for the multi-unit discount, but do not count as a unit.</p> <p>Ag Tractors</p>

Substitution	<p><b>Not Applicable.</b> This is a current price contract.</p>										
Trade-In	<p><b>Allowed:</b> Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order or quote as Trade-In. The agency and the dealer will determine the trade-in value.</p>
