Eligibility – You must have been a graduate of Edison High School, having attended EHS or EHOVE (as an Edison student) for at least the last two years of your high school education. You must have an undergraduate degree and/or be currently enrolled in a human health science doctoral program at an accredited college or university. You may re-apply each year that you are enrolled in the same program.

You must provide the following:

- 1. Documentation of acceptance into the doctoral health science program
- 2. Official transcripts from at least one full semester
- 3. Documentation that you have met the minimal passing grade for that institution's requirements to stay in the doctoral program

Wolf Doctoral Health Science Scholarship

Purpose: Doctoral health science not only take many years to complete but they can be among the most expensive. In addition to high tuition costs, there are cost of living expenses as well as lost earnings for the additional years someone is enrolled in a post graduate program. This scholarship is intended to help defray some of these expenses.

Potential Recipients: Edison High School graduates who are currently enrolled in Human Health Science Doctoral Programs. These include medicine (MD and DO), dentistry (DDS or DMD), nursing (DNP or PhD), pharmacology (PharmD), physical therapy (DPT), chiropractic (DC), optometry (OD), speech language pathology (SLP PhD), occupational therapy (OTD)

Requirements:

Recipients must:

- 1. Be a graduate of Edison HS, having attended EHS or EHOVE (as an Edison HS student) for at least the last two years of their high school education.
- 2. Be currently enrolled in a human health science Doctoral program.
- Submit application by April 15th with documentation of acceptance and official transcripts of at least one full semester and documentation of the minimal passing grade for that institution. If the program starts in the Spring, the application will not be considered until the following year.
- 4. Meet the academic institutions requirements for minimal passing grades to stay in the Doctoral program.
- 5. Applicants may re-apply each year if they remain enrolled in the same human health science Doctoral program.

Amount of scholarship: The amount will vary depending on the number of applicants and the amount available for distribution each year. Scholarships will be presented at Edison High School's Scholarship Award Night however recipients are not expected to be present for this since they would be in their graduate school programs. Notification will be made by mail or email.
