



U.S. diesel fuel price decreases

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel decreased to \$4.00 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.8 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.65 a gallon, down 0.2 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$3.70 a gallon, down 2.9 cents from a week ago.
