



U.S. gasoline price increases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline increased to \$3.06 a gallon on Monday. That's up 0.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$3.93 a gallon, down 5.0 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Rocky Mountain region at \$2.67 a gallon, down 6.2 cents from a week ago.
