



U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline decreased to \$3.45 a gallon on Monday. That's down 3.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.08 a gallon, down 2.6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$3.01 a gallon, down 8.4 cents from a week ago.
