HON'BLE JUSTICE

It is to inform you that this matter having come before the court pursuant to an application under Communication Decency Act 1996 & Indian Penal Code Section 499, responsible for the sexual & defamatory content on their website. The above "liability for repetition" rule is subject to the general principle that to be held liable in sexual & defamation CM(M) 1250/2012.

Domain have Voilated the rules through publishing transmitting
information which is obscene in electronic form shall be punished on first
conviction with imprisonment of either description for a term which may
extend to three years and with fine which may extend to five lakh rupees
and in the event of a second or subsequent conviction with imprisonment

- of either description for a term which may extend to five years and also with fine which may extend to ten lakh rupees
- 2. Penalty for Misrepresentation Domain made misrepresentation, or suppresses any material fact from, the Controller or the Certifying Authority for obtaining any license or Digital Signature Certificate, as the case may be. Shall be punished with imprisonment for a term, which may extend to two years, or with fine which may extend to one lakh rupees, or with both. words either spoken or intended to be read, or by signs or by visible representations, makes or publishes any imputation concerning any person intending to harm, or knowing or having reason to believe that such imputation will harm, the reputation of such person, is said, except in the case here in after expected, to defame that person.
- 3. It may amount to defamation to impute anything to a deceased person, if the imputation would harm the reputation of that person if living, and is intended to be hurtful to the feelings of his family or other near relatives.
- 4. An imputation in the form of an alternative or expressed ironically, may amount to Defamation.

It may amount to decadency act & defamation to make an imputation concerning a company or an association or collection of persons as such.

It is ordered that the above context laws Under Communication Decency Act 1996 & Section 499 IPC are being violated by the domain and have to face the charges as written in paragraph (1) and (2) for the violation as prefaced.
