



The Limits of Signs

Jesus refused to do religious stunts or signs.



*“Neither will they be convinced if
someone rises from the dead.”* Luke 16:31

Necessity of General Understanding of God

Our understanding must grow *before* we can have any significant appreciation of what we are experiencing on occasions when God intervenes in our lives. (87)

Matthew 16: Peter's Confession (16-17) & Confusion (22-23)

Two Key Questions:

Q1 – What kind of world do we live in?

Q2 – How does God relate to us, confined as we are within [our world]?



A Common, Honest Response to “Hearing God”

1. God would not communicate with run of the mill people
2. God does not communicate with them (us) in that way
3. God cannot do so
4. God should not

Four Truths of “Hearing God”

I. God Would (89) - Jesus made it clear how accessible God is to the weak. - “such as these” “poor in spirit”

II. God Does (90-93) - Are we in tune *and* ready vessels to do business with God? - “ears to hear” “Thy will be done”

Is his voice an unwelcome intrusion or a day-to-day reality?

III. God Can (94) - Does God have to go through physical substance? - “In Him all things hold together” Colossians 1:17

IV. God Should (106) - Unity is the light of the world, the aim of all humanity. - “Lord, open his eyes that he may see”

Never stoop to drive, manipulate, manage...simply call and walk.

Flashback to Chapter 1

The Ministry of Eli — I Samuel 3:8-9

Dallas learned to wait upon “the Word of God” to come to him. When a certain something more was taking place...

Great Christians of the past gave further insight. (19)



Flashback to Chapter 3

The union with God consists chiefly in a conversational relationship with God while we are consistently and deeply engaged as His friend and colaborer in the affairs of the Kingdom of the Heavens. (75 & 35)

His direct communication with us, by word and by shared activity, is the most important part. This is because we are to become the temple of God. (76)

“I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.” Galatians 2:20

God's Friends...for Good...as the Temple of God.

Flashback to Chapter 3

We become so close to God we don't have to wait to hear His words. We don't have to be asked but are engaged in free-hearted collaboration with Jesus and His friends in the Kingdom.




Session 5 Summary




