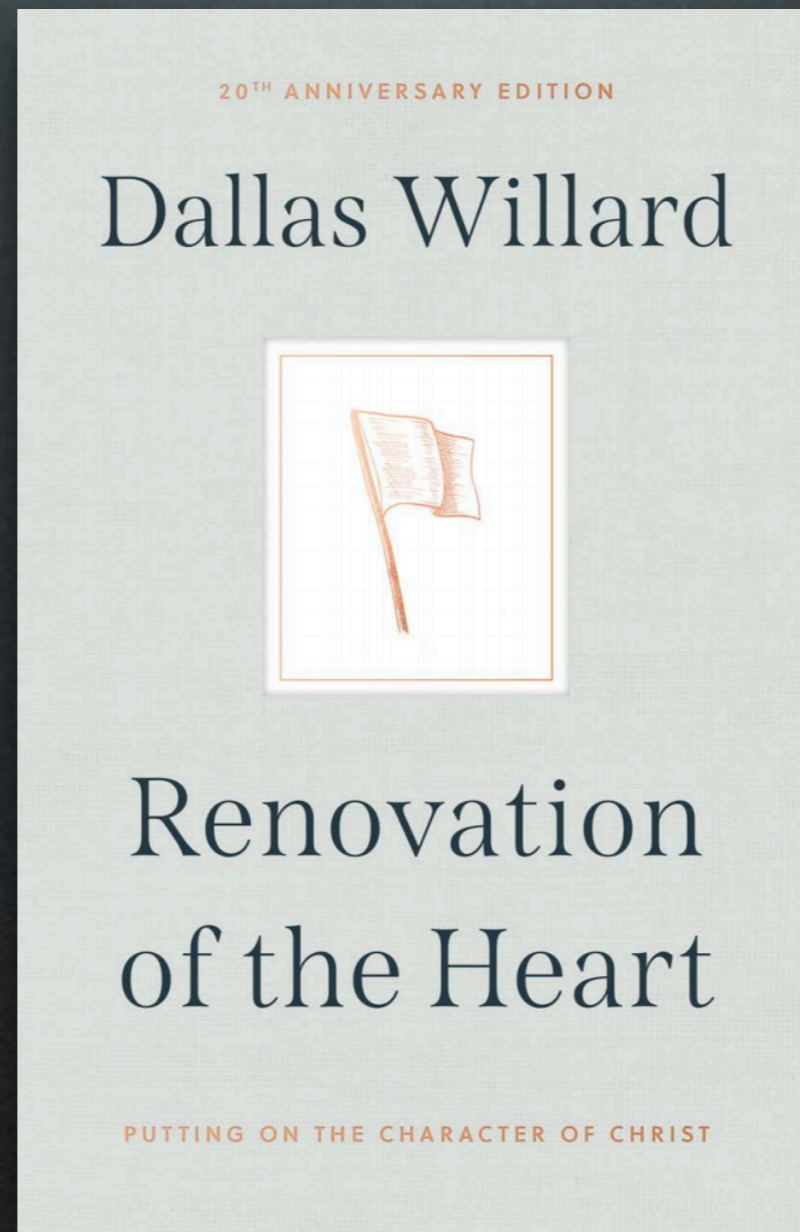

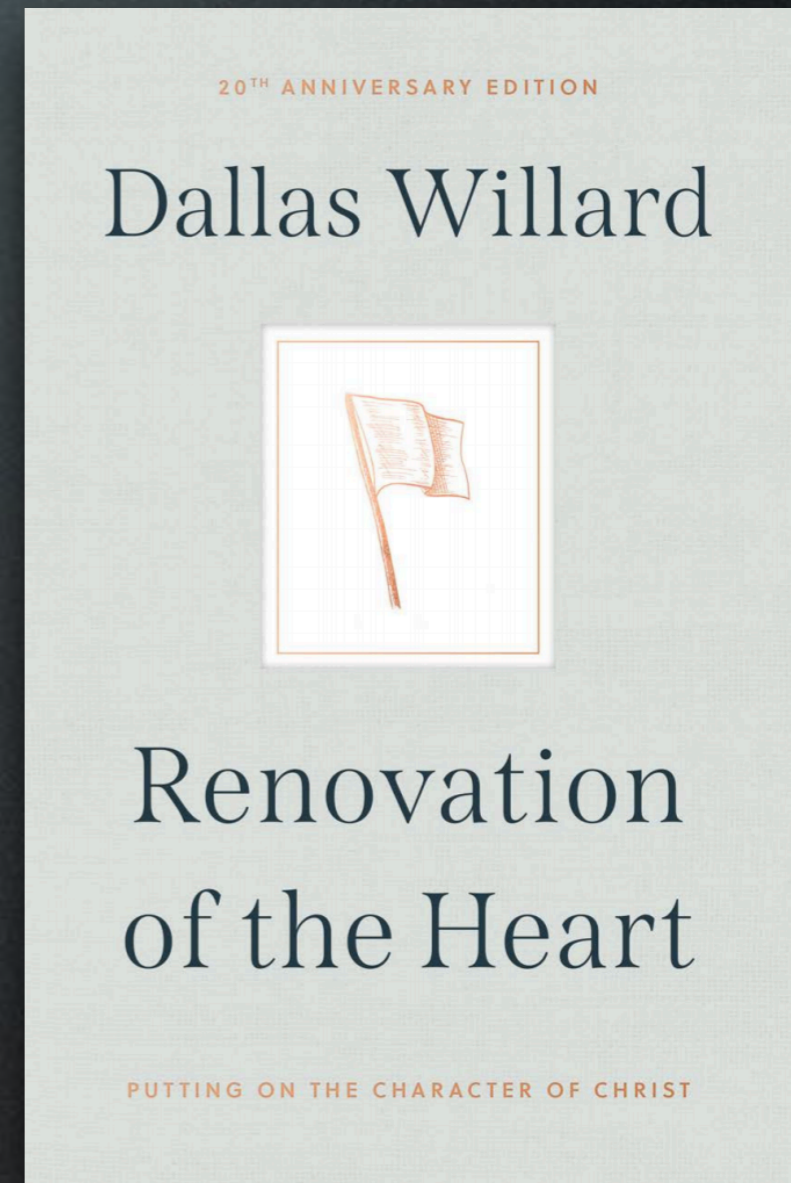

now really willing.*


Self-denial is always the surrender of a lesser, dying self for a greater eternal one. Jesus does not deny personal fulfillment, but shows us the only true way to it.

He was crucified so we could be crucified with Him.

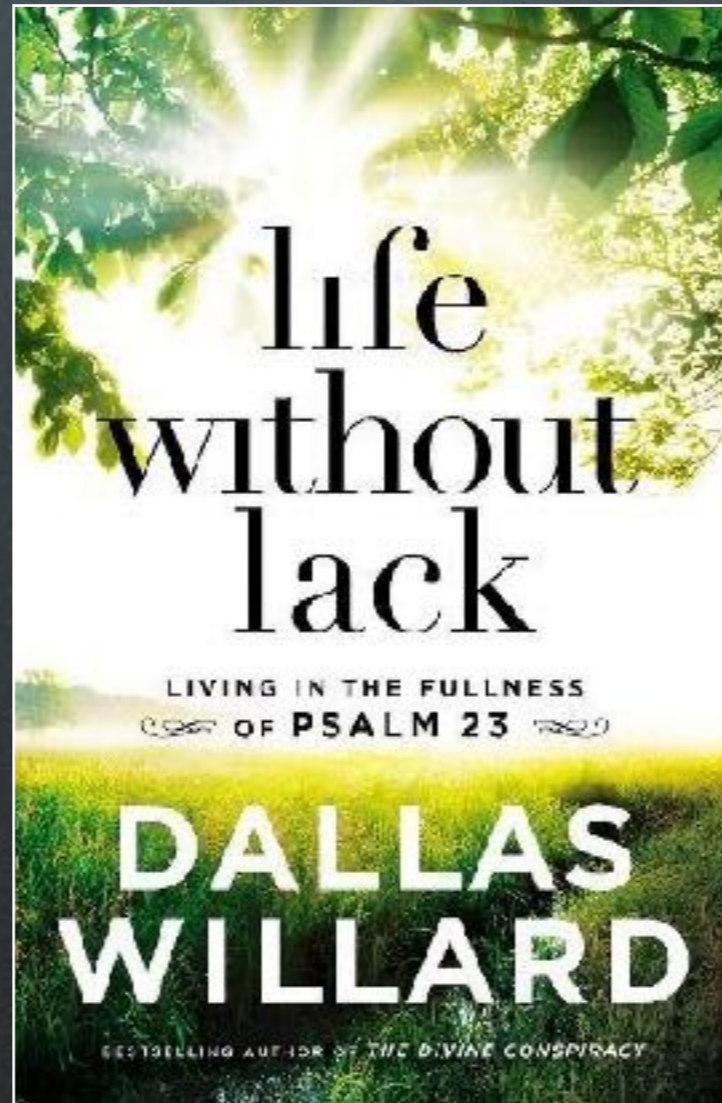

What remarkable changes this introduces into our day-to-day life!

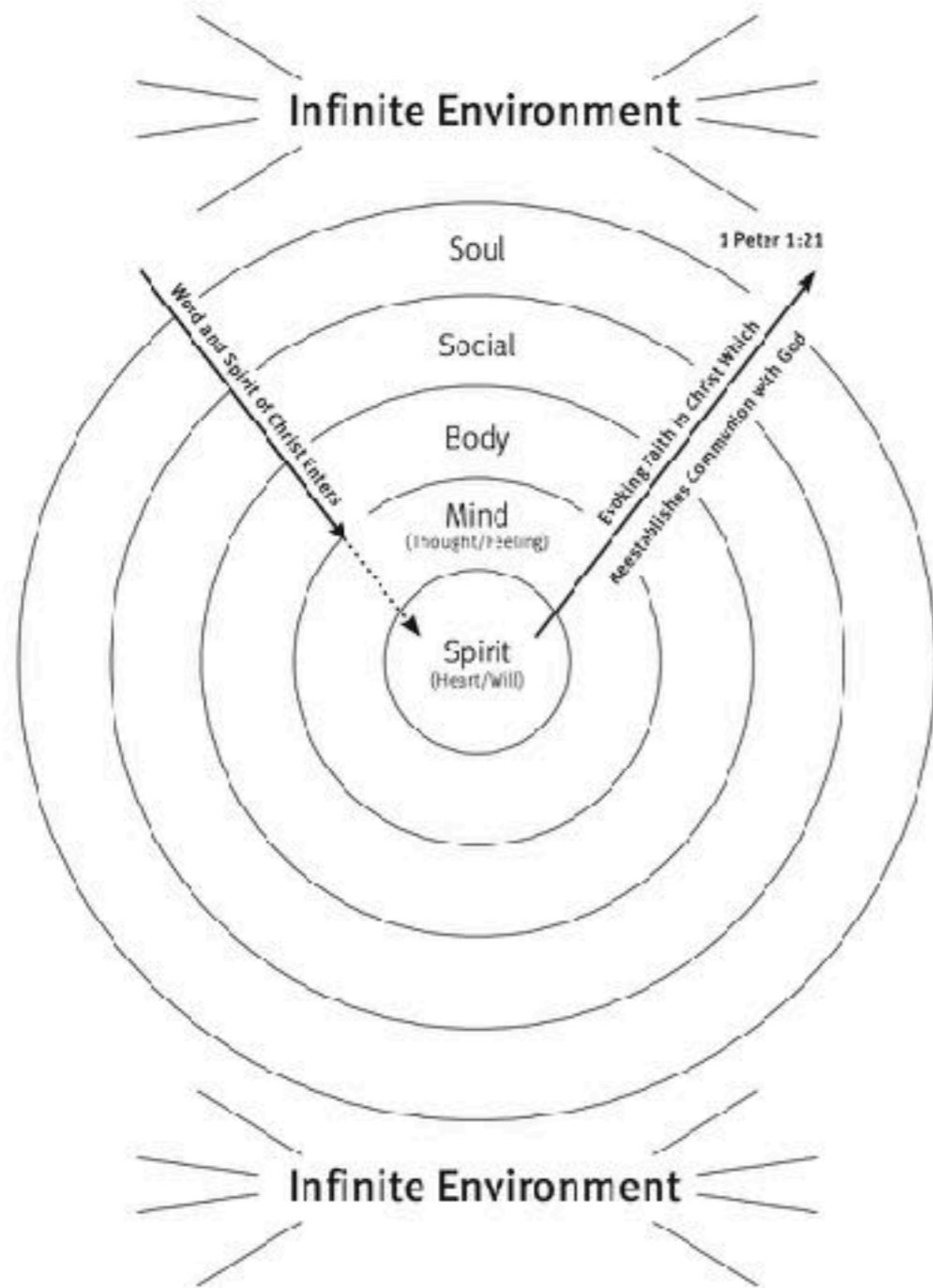

Dead to Self

Apprentices of Jesus... [God is in charge of our life]

...not getting what they want does not surprise or offend them and has no control over them.

...will be deeply disturbed about many things and will passionately desire many things, but they will be largely indifferent to the fulfillment of their own desires as such.

Merely getting their way has no significance for them, does not disturb them.

...will certainly not even notice some things that others would - social slights, verbal put-downs and insults, or physical discomforts.

...do not worry about outcomes.

...are not controlled by self-exaltation or the will to have their way.

...are easily controlled by love of God and neighbor.

Standing for the Right Without Egotism

“Unless a grain of wheat falls to the earth and dies**, it remains by itself alone; but if it dies**, it bears much fruit.” John 12:24-24

* * This is fully demonstrated in the life of Jesus.

* * It is the controlling principle of the renovated heart and the restored soul. Its radical goodness progressively subverts and replaces the radical evil in the fallen human heart, mind, body, soul, and social and other environment.

Beyond Anger, Retaliation & Unforgiveness*

Jesus — “But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also.”

Paul — “Don’t repay evil for evil, but always seek after that which is good.”

Peter — “Do not return evil for evil, insult for insult, but give a blessing instead.”

These remarkable teachings presuppose that one has laid down the burden of having our own way. We cannot begin to even understand it, except for a posture of self denial based on the confidence and experience of God's all-sufficient** presence in our lives.

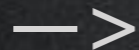

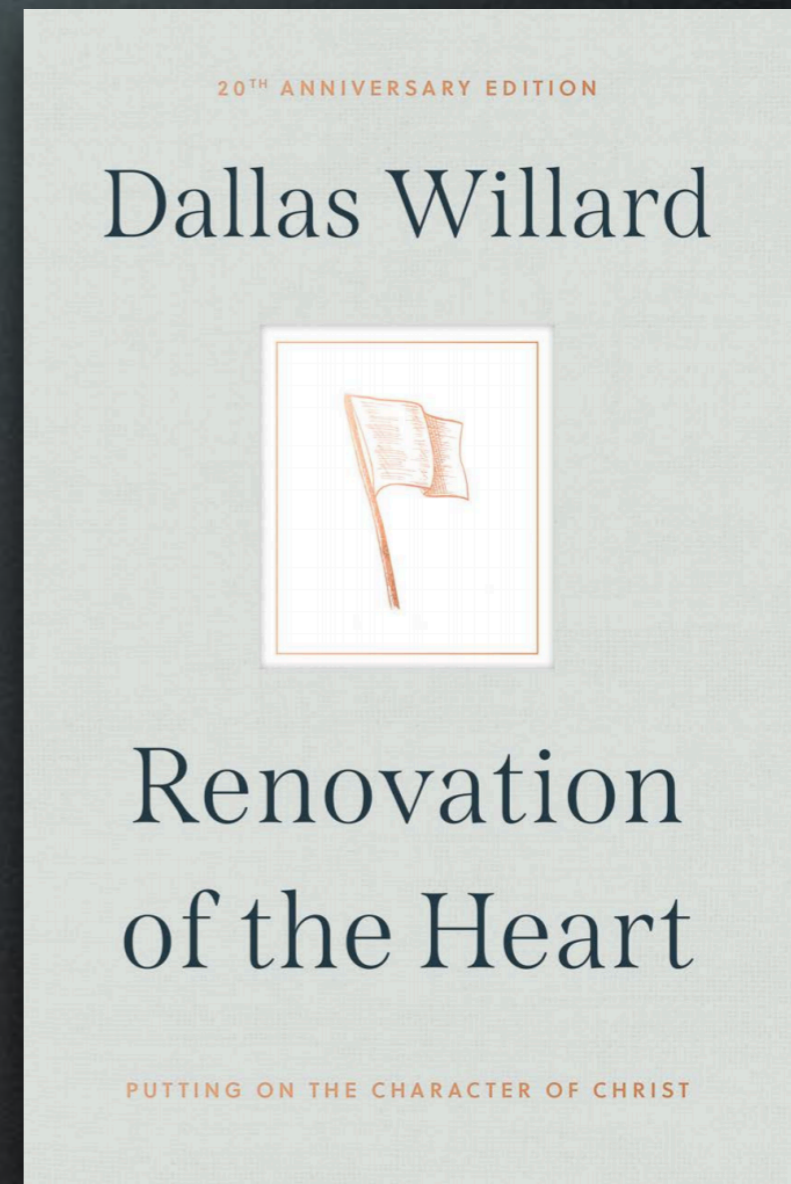

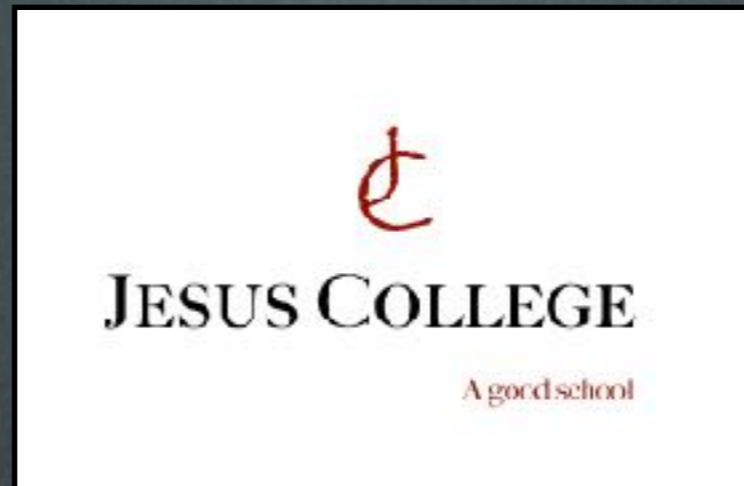
