

National Junior Honor Society Requirements

Eligibility Requirements include:

The student must be in the 7th grade for March/April eligibility:

- An average of 92% or greater in quarter one of 7th grade
- An average of 92% or greater in quarter two of 7th grade
- No failing grades in any course
- An outstanding record of leadership in school activities or organizations
- Demonstrates appropriate school behavior (disciplinary referrals and report card comments considered)

If the student did not meet the requirements for spring eligibility in 7th grade, grades will be submitted to advisors in September of 8th grade where they will be presented with an application and a chance to apply again.

September Eligibility (Students will be in the 8th grade):

- an average of 92% or greater in quarter three of 7th grade
- an average of 92% or greater in quarter four of the 7th grade
- No failing grades in any course
- An outstanding record of leadership in school activities or organizations
- Demonstrates appropriate school behavior (disciplinary referrals and report card comments considered)

If students are found eligible, they will be given an application where they must include:

- how they have been an active participant in at least one school activity and one community activity;
- a description of their experiences as a leader;
- why they wish to become a member of the National Junior Honor Society (this part must be explained in a well developed paragraph using two of the MYP learner profile traits).

Once applications are submitted, the NJHS Faculty Committee will meet to review each application and determine who meets the criteria for acceptance. If any of the above requirements are not met, or the applications are not submitted on time, the students will not be eligible to be inducted.
