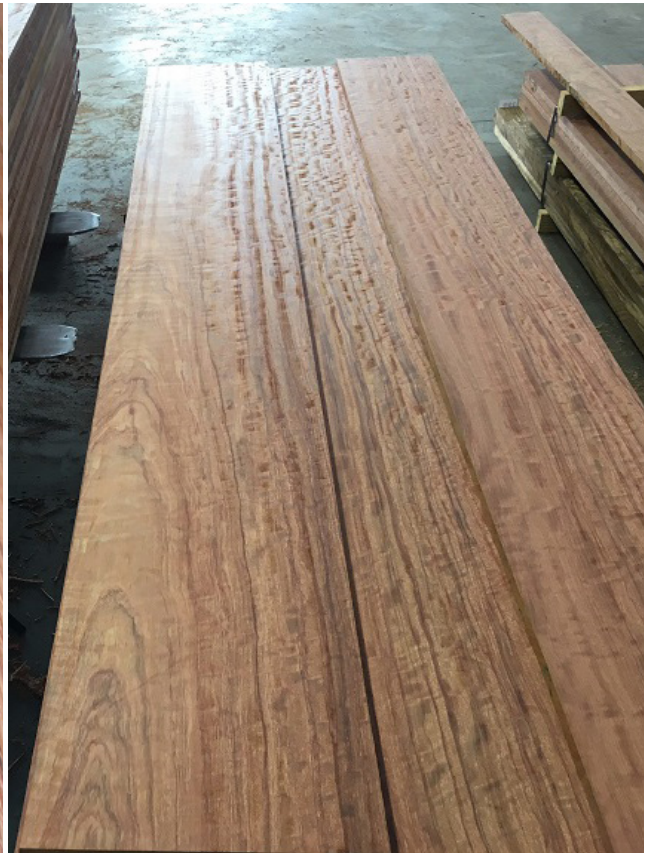


BUBINGA

Our Bubinga (also known as African Rosewood) is harvested in Africa and used in a variety of Millwork products such as furniture, cabinetry, turned objects, and other specialty items. It has good termite resistance and is moderately durable. The heartwood ranges from pinkish red to a darker reddish brown, sometimes with darker purple or black streaks.

*Uniform Pinkish Red to Dark Red, Dark Purple to Black Streaks.
Staright or Interlocked Grain, Uniform Fine to Medium Texture.*
