

IS THERE A NEED FOR YOUR SPEED?

Between 1975 and 2020, 375 law enforcement officers died operating motor vehicles while driving too fast for conditions or at an excessive rate of speed.¹ Before you accelerate, remember, **speed is the strongest risk factor for a fatality in a motor vehicle collision.**²
