SUBJECT: Measure L – Adjusted Salaries for Elected Officials – Fiscal Year 2025

Per section 1 of the Fiscal Year 2025 Salary Ordinance adopted on April 22, 2024 (<u>0-21794</u>), this is to notify you of a salary adjustment for the Mayor, City Attorney and Councilmembers effective July 1, 2024.

Pursuant to City Charter Section 11.1, the Chief Financial Officer is responsible for setting and adjusting the salaries of the City Councilmembers, Mayor, and City Attorney, as provided in sections 12.1, 24.1, and 40, respectively. The salaries paid to the City Councilmembers, Mayor, and City Attorney are determined based on a specified formula of salaries paid to Superior Court judges by the State of California. When compared to the salary for a California Superior Court judge, the salaries for the Mayor and City Attorney should be set equal while Councilmembers should be set at seventy-five percent (75%).

Attached is a letter from the California Department of Human Resources dated August 19, 2024, noting a recent adjustment to judicial salaries. Below is a table depicting the salaries that should be implemented retroactively by the Personnel Department, effective July 1, 2024.
