

Changes to train times

This week

Monday 27 to Friday 31 January

Urgent repairs to the track in the Ladywell area

Damage has been discovered to the track near Ladywell. Our partners at Network Rail advise that a specialist part is required, which isn't immediately available and needs to be specially produced.

Until the repairs have been completed, we need to make some temporary changes as follows on the Hayes line in order to continue to run the same number of trains on the route. Some trains are not stopping at Eden Park or New Beckenham, however during the weekday evening 'peck' period from London, trains will stop at all stations as usual.

- Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday**
- 08 and 38 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Hayes services will depart as scheduled, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge and will then be diverted to call at Ladywell and all stations to Hayes, except for New Beckenham and Eden Park, arriving at Hayes at 23 and 53 minutes past the hour.
 - 29 and 59 minutes past the hour Hayes to Charing Cross services, will depart at 32 and 02 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Ladywell, except Eden Park and New Beckenham, then London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.

Engineering work will affect the following late night services:

- Mondays from 2345** - Ashford to Minster via Canterbury West line is closed. Replacement bus services will run from Ashford and alternative train services to Ramsgate only.

- 0032 Grove Park to Bromley North will not run.

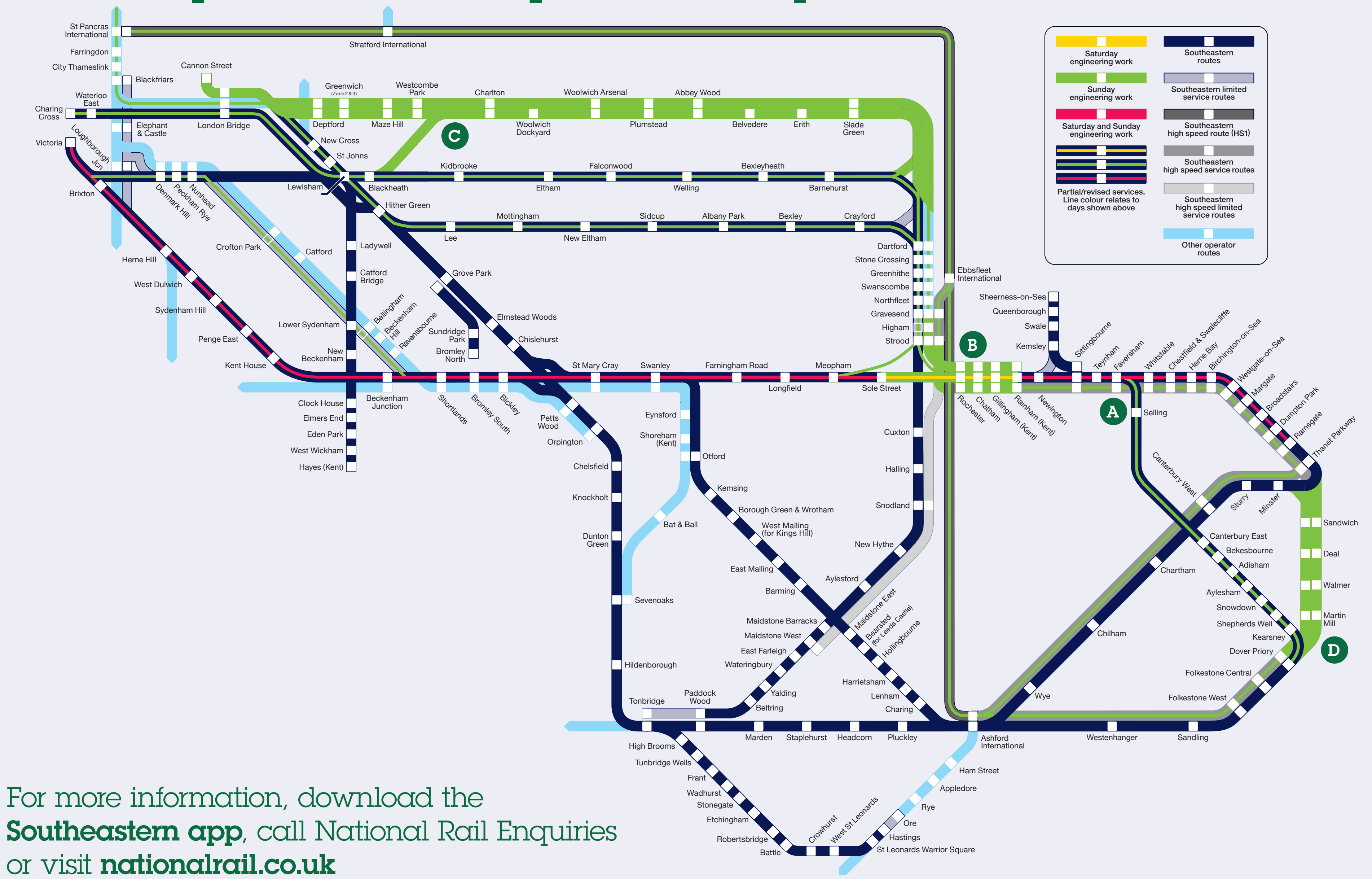

A scheduled Saturday service will operate on all Southeastern routes, with the following exception.

- A** Engineering work is taking place between Faversham and Margate on Saturday 1 February
- 0010 Victoria to Ramsgate, will terminate at Faversham. A replacement bus service will run from Faversham at 0130, and set down only at Margate, Broadstairs, Dympton Park and Ramsgate. A replacement bus service will run from Faversham at 0132, and set down only at all stations to Margate.

Sunday 2 February

No Southeastern services will run to/from Cannon Street

- B** Engineering work is taking place between Sole Street/Strood and Rainham on Sunday 2 February
- 40 minutes past the hour Victoria to Ramsgate services, will call at Denmark Hill, Bromley South, St Mary Cray, Swanley and then all stations to Sole Street.

- 50 minutes past the hour Dover Priory to Victoria services, will start from Sole Street at 50 minutes past the hour and then call as scheduled.
- A replacement bus service will run from Rainham, calling at Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, Strood and Meopham.
- Train services will depart from Ramsgate at 02 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Faversham, then Sittingbourne and Rainham.
- Train services will depart from Dover Priory at 25 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Rainham.

- 21 minutes past the hour Ramsgate to St Pancras International via Faversham services, will start from Strood at 35 minutes past the hour, and then run as scheduled. A replacement bus service will run from Rainham, calling at Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, Strood and Meopham.
- 49 minutes past the hour Margate to St Pancras International via Canterbury West services, will start from Faversham at 16 minutes past the hour, calling additionally at Whitstable, Herne Bay, Birchington-on-Sea and then as scheduled from Margate.
