History of the St. Clement Parish Community

St. Clement Parish, located in historic Lakewood, Ohio, was established by Bishop Joseph Schrems on April 22, 1922, to help meet the needs of Lakewood's growing Catholic population. Father Joseph J. Schmit, was the first pastor. Groundbreaking took place on August 17, 1922, and the parish celebrated its first Mass in the new church the following April.

In September of 1924, St. Clement School opened its doors to 350 students under the direction of the Sisters of St. Joseph.

In 2005 St. Clement School merged with the schools of St. Luke and St. James parishes to form Lakewood Catholic Academy.

In his letter of March 12, 2009, Bishop Lennon informed the St. Clement community that it would remain open as one of the three parishes serving Lakewood and Western Cleveland.
