



Ford Field Health and Safety

Please note that health and safety protocols are subject to change based on the latest CDC Guidelines, State and Local Officials, and the NFL.

Face Coverings

Face coverings will be mandatory for anyone in-stadium (guests and staff) and must cover your nose and mouth at all times (other than while actively eating or drinking in your ticketed seats), including during security screening. Wearing a face covering not only helps to protect you but also other guests.

Social Distancing

Guests are required to follow all six-foot social distancing markers that will be displayed throughout Ford Field and must maintain at least six-foot social distance whenever possible, even where markers are not available. These markers will help you line up for security screening, restrooms, shops and concessions.

Pod Seating

Depending on capacity limits and social distancing guidelines, some stadium seating in a suite may be closed to promote social distancing between adjacent suites and seating bowl seats. Signage will be clearly displayed, reinforcing social distancing guidelines in seating areas and on concourses. Suite guests should be prepared to attend games with individuals they trust to be healthy, as suites will be considered one single pod of attendees.

Feeling Ill?

Guests should be prepared to not come to the stadium if they have COVID-19, develop COVID-19 symptoms at any point before stadium entry on game day, or know they've been exposed to COVID-19. On game day, guests should check their temperature before leaving home. If it is above 100.4, please stay home.
