

FORMING THE PAST PARTICIPLE IN SPANISH

-AR = -ado

Cansado

Cantado

Bailado

Estoy cansado.

I'm tired.

-ER & -IR = -ido

Tenido

Vivido

Comido

No he comido.

I haven't ate.

-ER & -IR* = -ído

Leído

Caído

Reído

No he leído ese libro.

I haven't read that book.

Note: the accented ending '-ído' is used with -ER & -IR verbs whose stem ends in 'a', 'e', or 'o'

USES OF THE PAST PARTICIPLE IN SPANISH

PERFECT TENSES



No **he** dormido nada.
I **haven't** slept at all.

ADJECTIVE



El niño está dormido.
The boy is asleep.

PASSIVE VOICE



Elle **fue** entrevistada.
Elle **was** interviewed.

ACTIVE VS PASSIVE VOICE IN SPANISH

ACTIVE VOICE



Cristóbal Colón **descubrió** América.
Christopher Columbus **discovered** America.

PASSIVE VOICE



América **fue descubierta** por Cristóbal Colón.
América **was discovered** by Christopher Columbus.
