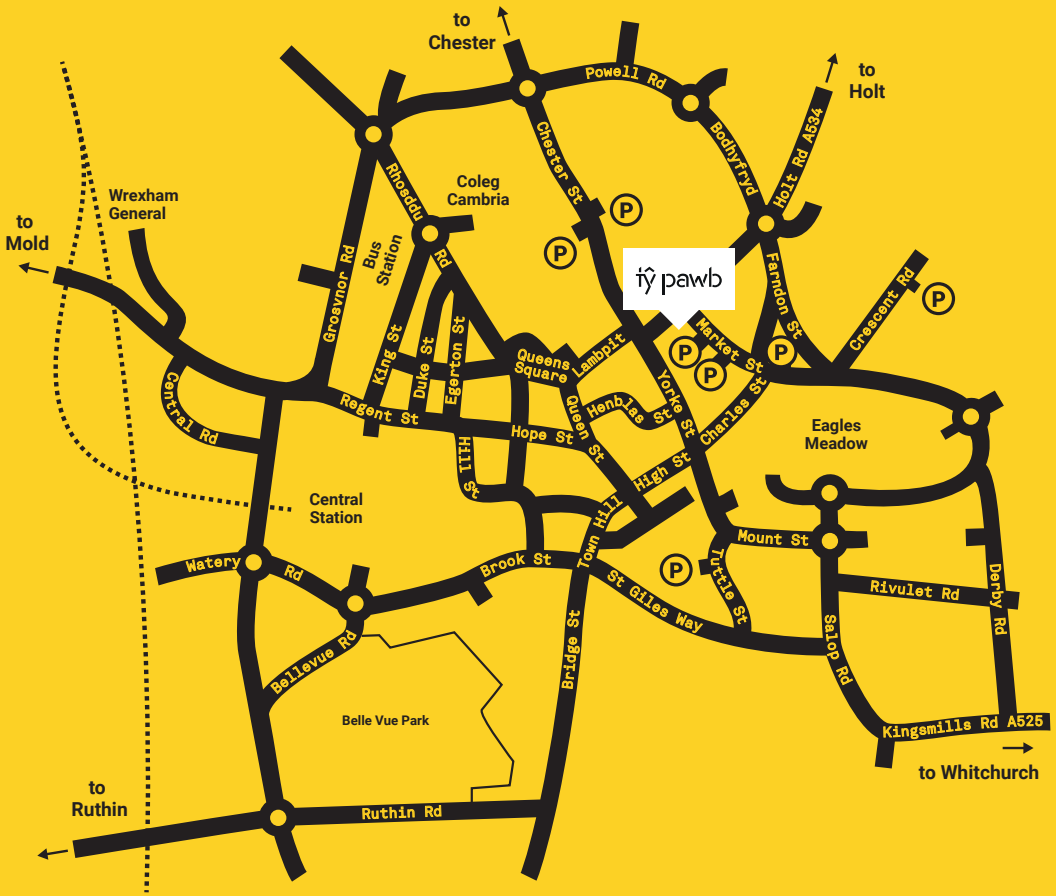

Julie Cope's Grand Tour: The Story of a Life by Grayson Perry

[Until April 22nd 2019](#)

Julie Cope is a fictional character created by Grayson Perry – an Essex everywoman whose story he has told through two large scale tapestries and an extended ballad presented in the exhibition.

The tapestries illustrate the key events in the heroine's journey from her birth during the Canvey Island floods of 1953 to her untimely death in a tragic accident on a Colchester street.

Rich in cultural and architectural details, the tapestries contain a social history of Essex and modern Britain that everyone can relate to.

The tapestries are shown alongside a graphic installation, and specially commissioned audio recording of The Ballad of Julie Cope, a 3000 word narrative written and read by Perry himself that illuminates Julie's hopes and fears as she journeys through life.

Uptwist Downtwist

Running concurrently with Julie Cope's Grand Tour, Uptwist Downtwist celebrates Wrexham's industrial weaving heritage at the Celanese Factory.

Featuring work by artist Will Cruickshank; work by students from Coleg Cambria in collaboration with former factory staff and artist Don Braisby. Archival material from the factory has been provided by Celanese staff and their families.







Rare Beauty

5th April – 5th May

Rare Beauty is an exhibition of photographs by Ceridwen Hughes, shedding new light on rare diseases through portraits of patients, their families and their medical practitioners.

The images show their subjects dressed in special occasion wear during hospital visits, creating a thought-provoking juxtaposition and starting point for conversations around illness, disability healthcare, identity and beauty.



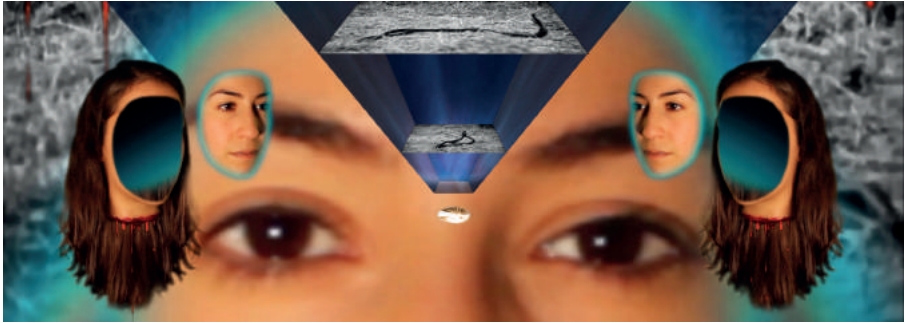
Futbolka

4th May – 21st July 2019

Embracing Wrexham's significant footballing heritage and how football can be used as a tool for social change.

This exhibition displays artefacts relating to the history of football in Wrexham, alongside contemporary artworks that reflect football's influence nationally and globally.

The social impact of football kits and growing culture of radical football zines are important aspects which are explored. Futbolka takes its name from the black and white vertically striped shirt, which became the embodiment of post-revolutionary soviet unisex clothing – an emblem of vitality.



Molly Palmer: Nine Nectarines and other Porcelain

1st June – 28th July 2019

A new commission by Tŷ Pawb, this solo exhibition will incorporate film, music, performance and sculpture by Molly Palmer. The themes that this exhibition explores range from perceived neurological differences to capitalism and Greek mythology.
