**A MOMENT OF TRUTH: SPECIAL ADDRESS ON CLIMATE ACTION

*On World Environment Day, UN Secretary-General Guterres will deliver a pivotal speech  
at the American Museum of Natural History*

NEW YORK, NY (30 May 2024) – As climate records are shattered and emissions continue to rise, on **Wednesday, 5 June**, at 10:00 AM EDT, **UN Secretary-General António Guterres** will set out some hard-hitting truths about the state of the climate, the grotesque risk leaders are running, and what companies and countries — particularly the G7 and the G20 — need to do over the next eighteen months to salvage humanity’s chances of a livable future. The Secretary-General will also share new data from the World Meteorological Organization, the Copernicus Climate Change Service, and the Indicators of Global Climate Change.
