


APOLLO CLUE CARD (EMD-A)

EXTRA BAGGAGE

BUILD THE PNR

Book the flight and prepare the PNR. It is recommended to add fare & frequent flyer Information before displaying the service catalogue.

Display Service Catalogue: \$B/DASO



 Sell an ancillary from the catalogue: DAS01Lm (where m is the line number)

Note: Only one EMD-A per Ancillary service item is permitted

Example:


Sell 1st additional bag from the catalogue



Receive and end the PNR

The banner **ADDITIONAL SERVICES EXIST** and **SERVICE INFORMATION EXISTS** should display. If it doesn't, ignore and re-retrieve the PNR.

DISPLAY ADDITIONAL SERVICES: *DAS



Display service elements: *PS



**You should see an SSR ASVC for the service booked.

EMDI/Nn/**IC**ticketnumber (where n is the passenger number)

ITINERARIES WITH MORE THAN 2 CONNECTIONS

Itineraries that contain more than 2 connections require a manual workaround. Segment select the last connection in order for baggage ancillary to price correctly as a portion. If the last connection is not segment selected this will be priced by sector.
